## **Field Safety Guidelines**

The Department of General Services (DGS) advises caution when using recreational services throughout the District during heat emergency. Fields can get hot on warm, sunny days. Please use caution.

#### **Always Remember:**

- Drink plenty of water
- Wear light clothing
- Always wear shoes
- Take breaks often
- Exercise moderately
  - If you experience symptoms of heat related illness, such as dizziness, weakness, headache, vomiting or muscle cramps, move to a shaded area, drink water, and rest.
    Seek medical attention if you do not feel better.

### **Tips for Protecting Human Health:**

- No bare feet
- No dogs or other animals except for service animals
- No picnics, meals or open containers
- Do not eat grass blades, infill or soil
- Wash hands and exposed body parts thoroughly after using the field
- Shake clothing vigorously before leaving fields so avoid tracking dust and debris to other locations

#### **Tips for Maintaining Field Health:**

- No vehicles, bikes ATVs, in-line stakes, skateboards or scooters; except mobility devices
- No smoking, grilling, or open fires
- No metal cleats (applies to synthetic turf fields only)
- Do not insert stakes or support posts into field surface
- No chewing gum
- No littering or dumping of debris
