



FEREBEE HOPE PLAYGROUND CONSTRUCTION UPDATE OCTOBER 2014



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Ferebee Hope Playground Renovation includes a Tot Lot for 2 – 5 year old children; a play area for 5 – 12 year old children; fitness equipment for all ages; a community garden; ADA improvements to make the site accessible from the street to the playground; game tables, benches, and a picnic area.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction is ready to begin!

Fencing was installed around the playground construction site on October 22nd. This fencing has been put in place for everyone's safety – both the children and adults who use the Ferebee Hope Recreation Center and the construction workers.

The recreation center will remain open during the construction.

The project next steps include:

- Site demolition such as removing the existing playground equipment, hand rail and the removal of tree limbs to make room for the new play equipment.
- Removal of one tree that is not healthy enough to survive construction
- Protecting the remaining existing trees around the playground to prevent damaged during construction.
- Site Excavation
