This Addendum No. 4 is being issued via email and is effective as of the date shown above. Except as modified hereby, the Invitation for Bids ("IFB") remains unmodified.

Item #1: Insert the following language at the end of Section C.1.:

"In addition, a chain link safety/security enclosure with lockable gate and combination lock shall be installed at the following locations: 107 Wayne Place SE (see CLIN 002 below), 117 Wayne Place SE (see CLIN 003 below), 1701-1711 V Street SE (see CLIN 004 below) and 1626 Kramer Street NE (see CLIN 005 below). The chain link safety/security enclosure shall be 8 feet high, galvanized 2 inch mesh of 9-gauge steel. Terminal posts shall be 3 inch outside diameter, type 40 steel. Line posts shall be 2 ½ outside diameter. Gates are to be 3 feet wide and 8 feet high. Maintenance service clearances shall be provided as per project drawings, specifications and manufacturer's recommendations.

The Bidder further represents and warrants that no further action or approval must be obtained by the Bidder in order to authorize the terms of the Bidder's bid.
- 4. The Bidder and its principal team members hereby represent and warrant that they have not: (i) colluded with any other group or person that is submitting a bid in response to the IFB in order to fix or set prices; (ii) acted in such a manner so as to discourage any other group or person from submitting a bid in response to the IFB; or (iii) otherwise engaged in conduct that would violate applicable anti-trust law.
- 5. The Bidder hereby certifies that neither it nor any of its team members have entered into any agreement (written or oral) that would prohibit any contractor, subcontractor or subconsultant that is certified by the District of Columbia Office of Department of Small and Local Business Enterprises as a Local, Small, Resident Owned or Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (collectively, "LSDBE Certified Companies") from participating in the work if another company is awarded the contract.

Demolish what is necessary to install the new standby generator, generator pad and chain link enclosure ensuring manufacturer's recommended service clearances.
2	I would like to have a rigging contractor visit the Corcoran and La Casa locations and a concrete contractor visit the Kramer Shelter. Please verify if we can schedule our visits and who we would need to contact.	Vendor can schedule a visit to the La Casa Shelter location.
