

L.17 “Special Standards of Responsibility”.</p> <p>a) Does this information get submitted with our bid or does it get submitted afterwards by the apparent low bidder?</p> <p>b) Paragraph (h) requires information from proposed sub-contractors. Typically, the contractor does not receive sub-contractor pricing until the last minute on the day of the bid. Can this information be submitted 24 hours after the bid is turned in?</p>	<p>The information required under Section L.17 Special Standards of Responsibility (of the IFB) must be submitted with the Bid(s).</p>
