DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS FOR SOLE SOURCE EXTENSION OF A COMPETITIVELY AWARDED CONTRACT BEYOND FIVE YEARS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code §2-354.04, 27 DCMR Chapter 13 1304.1, 1700, 1701, 2005.2(b)

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Department of General Services ("DGS" or the "Department"), on behalf of Facilities Management Division ("FMD"), has an immediate need for the current Contractor, RSC Electrical & Mechanical ("RSC" or "Contractor") to continue providing Consolidated Maintenance Services at Frank D. Reeves Center ("Reeves") for an additional period of up-to four (4)-months and twenty eight (28)-days, through 31-May-2021 and until the Department awards of a new contract. This additional four (4)-month and twenty-eight (28)-day extension will assure the avoidance of any disruption to critical facility operation services during the impending period while a new solicitation for these services is procured following significant scope changes.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and reasonable price for the four (4)-month and twenty-eight (28)-day sole source contract extension is Four Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$476,326.67) for Basic Services, and Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and zero cents (\$250,000.00) for cost reimbursement, for a Total Not-to-Exceed Contract Ceiling of Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars and ninety-eight cents (\$726,326.67).

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY A SOLE SOURCE EXTENSION OF CONTRACT:

It is the mission of DGS to provide first rate maintenance at District government facilities and to ensure a safe environment for the citizens, students, faculty, employees and visitors of the District of Columbia. The purpose of this sole source contract extension is to prevent an imminent threat to health, welfare, safety and serious disruption in agency operations at Reeves.

- 1. On January 4, 2016, the Contractor, RSC Electrical & Mechanical ("RSC"), was awarded the contract to provide consolidated maintenance services at the Frank D. Reeves for a twelve (12)-monthly base year period and four additional, one (1) year option periods.
- 2. The Department has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to extend the current contract with RSC from January 4, 2021 through May 31, 2021, a total of four (4)-months and twenty-eight (28)-days where RSC will continue providing consolidated maintenance services at the Frank D. Reeves Center as defined under the original contractual agreement.
- 3. The Department is in the process of conducting significant changes and updates to the current scope of work and intends to issue a new solicitation within the next 30-days.
- 4. The incumbent is currently providing consolidated maintenance services at the Frank D. Reeves Center and the continuity of these services is vital to the District.
- 5. The continuation of services being provide under the current contract with the incumbent is the most advantageous method to assure continuity of services delivery. This plan includes the continuation of service against the current contract DCAM-16-NC-0005A with no changes in monthly costs for basic services and hourly rates for supplemental reimbursable services.
- 6. RSC Electrical & Mechanical, the current Contractor, is providing satisfactory services and is uniquely positioned to ensure continuity of services.
- 7. A sole source contract extension is the most advantageous method to minimize disruption to overall facility operations; it ensures a continuation of service while the District prepares and finalizes a solicitation for competition and awards a contract.
