FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code §2-354.04, 27 DCMR Chapter 13 1304.1, 1700, 1701, 2005.2(b)

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Department of General Services (“DGS” or the “Department”), on behalf of the Department of Human Services (“DHS”). We have an immediate requirement for the current Contractor to continue providing comprehensive, consolidated maintenance services encompassing building, maintenance, and operational aspects. These services are essential for the efficient functioning of Operations, Maintenance, and Repair (OM&R) services at the District's Ward 8 Short-Term Family Housing facility.

We are seeking an extension of up to twelve (12) months, October 25, 2023, through October 24, 2024, or until the Department awards a new contract. This additional twelve (12)-month extension is imperative to ensure the seamless operation of critical facility functions and to meet service requirements without any disruptions during this upcoming period.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and equitable total cost for the Short-Term Family Housing – Ward 8 Contract comprises \$403,769.52 for essential services and an additional \$150,000 for supplementary services. This combination results in a Not-to-Exceed (NTE) contract value of \$553,769.52.

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY A SOLE SOURCE EXTENSION OF CONTRACT:

DGS is committed to its mission of delivering top-tier maintenance services at District government facilities while prioritizing the safety and well-being of the citizens, staff, employees, and visitors in the District of Columbia. The primary objective behind this sole-source contract extension is to proactively avert any imminent threats to health, welfare, safety, and prevent significant disruptions at the Short-Term Family Housing - Ward 8 facility.

1. On October 18, 2018, Sustainable Facilities Management Services was granted a contract to deliver comprehensive maintenance services for the Ward 8 Short-Term Family Housing Facility. The initial contract covered a base year of twelve (12) months, along with the provision for four (4) additional one (1) year option periods.
2. The Department has concluded that extending the existing contract with the Contractor, spanning from October 18, 2023, to October 17, 2024, for a potential duration of up to twelve (12) months, is in the District's best interest. This extension will enable the Contractor to continue delivering consolidated maintenance services and supplemental services, ensuring the efficient execution of operations, maintenance, and repair (OM&R) services.



3. The Contractor is presently delivering consolidated maintenance services for various DC facilities, and the uninterrupted provision of these services is paramount to the facility's operational continuity in the District.
4. Continuing services under the current contract with the Contractor is the most advantageous method to assure continuity of service delivery includes the continuation of service against the current contract DCAM-18-NC-0112C for Consolidated Maintenance Services for Ward 8 Short-Term Family Housing.
5. The incumbent, in their role as the current Contractor, has consistently delivered satisfactory services and is thus uniquely positioned to ensure the seamless continuity of services.
6. A sole source contract extension is the most advantageous method to minimize disruption to overall facility operations; it ensures a continuation of service allowing the District the necessary additional time to adequately prepare to pursue the solicitation process under new social destinating guidelines handed down by both the Center for Disease Control (“DCD”) and the District Department of Health Agency guidelines.
7. In accordance with **Chapter 47 of title 27 of the DCMR 4720** Consolidated Maintenance Services for Ward 8 Short-Term Family Housing will be procured thorough the Sealed Bidding Process and the RFP will be publicized during FY24 Q1.
