DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS FOR AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT

CAPTION: Road Trailer at Benning Road Transfer Station

AGENCY: Department of General Services (DGS)

CONTRACTOR: Chiaramonte Construction Company ("Contractor" or "Chiaramonte")

FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code §2-354.05 and 27 DCMR 4719

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The District of Columbia, Department of General Services ("Department" or "DGS"), has an immediate need for a temporary road trailer, sewer facilities, and a power generator at Benning Road Transfer Station located at 3200 Benning Road, NE.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and reasonable price for the emergency contract is Fifty Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$50,680.00) for a temporary road trailer with sewer facilities and a power generator for six (6) months.

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT:

This work is needed to immediately install a temporary trailer, power, and sewer at 3200 Benning Road, NE. DGS-CCSD has recommended Chiaramonte as they have provided similar services to the District in the past.

Authorizing the emergency procurement will provide indoor conditioned spaces allowing the transfer station employees to rest, eat, meet, and use the restroom.

Accordingly, given the need for completion of this project as quickly as possible, the DGS-CCSD requests that the contract for this work be awarded via Emergency Procurement to Chiaramonte.

The recommendation is based on the following points:

- A full-blown solicitation will not allow adequate time to correct this immediate problem.
- Chiaramonte has extensive experience in trailer, sewer facilities, and generator rental.
- DGS-CCS has already contacted Chiaramonte which has performed an assessment of the needed work.
- If the services are not provided it could pose an imminent threat to health, welfare, and safety.
- The estimated cost to the District for the rental is fair and reasonable based on DGS' historical data on similar services.
