FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

Chapter 47 of title 27 of the DCMR Section 4719 and PPRA Sec. 405 (d); *Emergency Procurements*.

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Department of General Services (DGS) has an immediate need for DC Life Safety, LLC to provide Emergency Fire Watch Services, and providing fire alarm and safety, inspection and maintenance at Ben Murch Elementary School.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and reasonable price for Services is \$11,962.50.


4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT:

In accordance with the D.C. Official Code §2-354.05 and 27 DCMR 4719, the purpose of this emergency contract is to prevent undue threat to the public’s health and welfare which, create an unsafe environment with the risk to bodily harm. In addition, the services are required immediately, on an emergency basis to prevent a disruption of the daily operations at Ben Murch Elementary School. It is the mission and the responsibility of the Department of General Services to provide safe and healthy facilities to all District owned and or operated facilities throughout the District including D.C. Public School buildings as ordered under (D.C. Code § 10-551.01(b) (4), The Department of General Services Establishment Act of 2011.).
