3.	Who is responsible for obtaining and paying for the building permit?	Contractor is responsible for obtaining and paying for building permit. However, DGS will reimburse Contractor the exact permit fees paid to the DC Department of Buildings.
4.	Please confirm street and sidewalks permits will be required for this project.	Contractor is responsible for the means and method of executing the work and such shall apply and obtain all street and sidewalk permit needed for the work.

5.	Is there a hazmat study conducted for this project? Who is responsible for remediating the hazmat materials if it is found?	Mantis will provide the result ACM. The contractor will be responsible for remediating the hazmat materials. An allowance is provided for roofs if the roofs test positive for lead paint and asbestos.
6.	Are there parking spaces available for the contractors?	DGS/DCFD will provide (2) two parking spots for Contractor.
7.	Does DGS want bidders to include manufacturer's certifications in the name of the contractor being awarded/performing the roofing work? Examples of roofs does not mean those roofs did not leak after installation. Normally a manufacturer's certification is also needed to confirm the quality of the roofing company.	Contractor shall be certified to install at least one (1) of the three (3) specified roofing product manufacturers.
8.	Will DGS prioritize award to roofing contractors that hold Elite certifications from roofing manufacturers?	No, contract evaluation will be based on standard IFB process
9.	The solicitation docs show that the bid is due on $7/17/24$ on page 65, but also states it is due on $7/29/24$ on page 63. Can you please confirm?	Refer to Addendum 3.
10.	Page 3 of the solicitation docs indicates that the bid requires attachments as shown in section J.7, however there is no section J.7 in the solicitation docs. Can you please clarify?	The section being referred to is Section J.
