



## A FRESH START TO ENDING FAMILY HOMELESSNESS

### Traffic Control Plan Narrative

We have obtained four (4) approved Traffic Control Plans (TCP's) from the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) for upcoming work at the Ward 8 Short Term Family Housing project. Below is a brief description of the activities associated with each TCP:

#### TCP Phase 1, Utility Work –

To support the overall building functions we have to install new storm and sewer piping and manholes located on the west side of 6<sup>th</sup> Street (project site side). The majority of this work is underground and will require excavation and trenching in the street.

Duration: Mid-December 2017 - January 2018.

#### TCP Phase 2, Utility Work –

The second phase of the storm and sewer work will take place on the east side of 6<sup>th</sup> street (opposite of project site).

Duration: Mid-February 2018 - early April 2018.

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### Traffic Control Plan (cont'd)

#### TCP Phase 1, Alley Widening –

The new site plan includes improving the existing alley west of 6<sup>th</sup> Street to ease vehicular traffic and allow for a drop off area for the new housing project. Phase 1 consists of closing the alley entrance at both ends, installing vehicular signs, and allowing driver's to adjust to the new traffic pattern.

Duration: Work to begin March 2018.

#### TCP Phase 2, Alley Widening –

Phase 2 involves the actual demolition of the existing curbs and paving followed by installing a wider path for vehicles.

Duration: Work to start April 2018.
