- 1. I am concerned the location of the playground. Due to the lack of visibility from the outside. We want to discourage loitering as well as criminal activity and create more of a safe area with high visibility.
 - Thank you. We will take a look at the placement of the playground.
- 2. How large is the kitchen?
 - We don't have specific sq footages just yet since we're so early in the design process.
- 3. I'm interested since the lighting to add to what Kellie stated.
 - DPR works with a lighting consultant, MPD, and others to ensure proper placement lighting within the site.
- 4. How many levels/stories is center?
 - 2 levels.
- 5. Will early childhood have their own kitchen and eating space?
 - Yes.
- 6. Can the playground be moved more towards the parking lot?
 - We will take a look at the placement of the playground.
- 7. Can we create a space for little children? Maybe an indoor play space and kid's library?
 - Yes, we can look at that idea.
- 8. Is there a plan for an indoor pool?
 - No, there is no plan for an indoor pool at this time.
- 9. Yes, What about the indoor pool?
- 10. Yes, to an indoor pool!!!
- 11. Is there any designated indoor play space for young children?
 - Not at this time.
- 12. While the new spaces are very exciting, what are the plans for the existing structures? The pavilions and old fountain are falling apart. is the pool getting any attention? Splash park? HVAC for cultural center?
 - Many of the existing structures within the park will be getting upgrades. As the designs are finalized and we obtain market pricing, the final scope of work will be further developed, allowing us to more accurately answer this question.
- 13. We should vote on the pool.
- 14. I disagree with you.
- 15. The concern is the limited access with the trees and in between the buildings where we have a historical criminal activity and homeless people taking shelter at the old school. Can we look at the ability of moving the playground more forward where it can be seen from the parking lot to make it easier for residents to use as well besides the daycare? The current play spaces have no tables or shelter for people to host gatherings. Can we add tables and shelter to kids areas?
 - Yes, this can be considered.
- 16. Imagine this big recreational area without an indoor pool
- 17. Agree that we should vote on a pool
- 18. The Woodridge community has no green space. Our Rec Center and playground became a parking lot. How could this project safely benefit Woodridge? We are surrounded by major roadways that poses a hazard to children and adults to cross. Can you help us?

- 19. There is enough space for a pool
- 20. The taxpayers want an indoor pool
- 21. The indoor pool can only be used in the winter
- 22. In the summer, I meant
- 23. Please survey the community
- 24. I do not believe someone would say no to an indoor pool
- 25. We have no indoor pool on this side of town
- 26. Great point
- 27. Let's push for making this happen
- 28. It's not just about a pool or no pool, we would need to know what other items we would be giving up for the costs of a pool
- 29. I know that Langdon has an awesome splash park and pool and I personally go there instead of ours. if our existing pool isn't going to get any love than is there a benefit to keeping it open? just a thought.
 - We do wish to keep the outdoor pool open at Theodore Hagans.
- 30. A recreational center is not complete without an indoor pool
- 31. I use the Turkey Thicket indoor pool, but feel another indoor pool closer to or in Fort Lincoln is needed
- 32. Can we fix the current outdoor pool to be more kid friendly and handicap accessible (meaning a graded entrance)? The current kiddie pool is always closed because of a leak and bees. Plus the kiddie pool is only for babies not older children.
 - DPR will be looking at the entire site holistically to see which improvements can be completed given the project budget.
- 33. Construction has not started so there might be something we can do.
- 34. Can the Gazebo's be more accessible from the children's playground?
 - Yes, this is something we can look further into.
- 35. What's the budget allocation between the community center and ECE?
 - This allocation will be further refined as the project design unfolds.
- 36. What services will benefit the homeless, including homeless children?
 - DPR works with our sister agency at the Dept of Human Services to serve DC's unhomed residents.
- 37. Engage the community on voting on a larger scale
- 38. The current sidewalk area by the gazebo is all bricks uneven. Due to the seniors, handicap and small children, can the side walk areas inside the gazebo area be smoothed out to make it safer?
 - This is something we can consider moving forward.
- 39. This decision is going to affect all of us
- 40. 👍 indoor pool
- 41. The outdoor pool is only open for the summer months. Indoor water exercise classes can go year around.
- 42. The old school had indoor pool. It's part of Fort Lincoln history
- 43. In the community spaces, there is a teen and senior lounge, can there be a little kids space?
 - Yes, we have heard that both a teen and senior lounge are important to the community. There will also be spaces for younger children in the ECE.
- 44. will we get another survey to voice our input on prioritizing what we have seen this evening? It is going to be really hard to do all that has been discussed with the dollars allocated. it is better

to slim down the scope and do some of the elements really well than try to patch fix the campus. looking forward to seeing the next steps. thank you for all of this work.

- 45. how many stories is rec center?
 - The current design is a two-story facility.
- 46. Can the community center/fitness be more than one story to make it connect to the park and allow us to have space to grow?
 - Yes.
- 47. How can teens give feedback on the teen lounge?
 - DPR's programming division can work with the community teens to gather more feedback on the teen lounge.
- 48. YES! Please preserve the trees.
- 49. There are also some native perennial plants (as well as invasive, I realize) that could be saved/transplanted, perhaps to the community garden.
- 50. what's the plan for current outdoor playground area near tennis court... will that be new playground (or a parking area) or remain open?
 - The existing playground will be removed.
- 51. Will it be community garden or urban farm like Edgewood? A farm produces more food than a garden.
 - That portion of the design is still being analyzed.
- 52. Have you all considered using the rooftops of these community center sites for public areas and/or rentable space? We may be missing an opportunity to capitalize on this specific areas most valuable asset...the VIEW!!!
 - Yes! A final design and determination will be made based on the project budget.
- 53. Yes, Edgewood farm is amazing
- 54. Also, solar panels!! We should be making these facilities as green and environmentally friendly as possible. It will set a great example for many in the community, especially the young people.
- 55. I been to both. Kenilworth has cooking classes. I'm looking forward to the completion
- 56. When will the final spaces be confirmed, since we have potential ones right now? How will you engage the community on decision making?
 - The community outreach process will be announced and reviewed at upcoming community meetings.
- 57. Can we please install solar panels on some/all of the buildings?
 - This will be considered moving forward.
