

4		<p><b>Schematic Plans:</b> The Schematic plans show gym wing within +/-5ft of existing building and planned foundations overlapping with footprint of existing building. Should it be assumed that design will adjusted to avoid conflict or should gym be assumed in</p>	<p>AE will coordinate design so as to not impede construction progress/schedule.</p>

The Offeror shall ensure that a minimum of three (3) Past Performance Evaluation forms (Attachment L) are completed and submitted <b>on behalf of the Offer or directly to Courtney Washington</b> by the due date for proposals. May <b>we the Offeror</b> send the Past Performance Evaluation to Courtney Washington directly?	Yes
10	B.4.1	<b>Item B.4.1.</b> We have noted that the Design/Builder will assume the design contract 14 days after award in lieu of at the time of GMP execution. As that timeframe is accelerated, can DGS provide the design contract as part of this solicitation package?	The design agreement is not available.

11	D.4.1	<b>Item D.4.1.</b> criteria (i) and (ii) refer to renovation and adaptive reuse. As this project looks to be mainly new construction and demolition, may we omit those criteria?	See Amendment 5 Item #2
12	D.4.6	<b>Item D.4.6</b> Paragraph 2 references addressing two approaches outlined in section A.1. Could DGS please clarify?	See response to question #7.
13		<b>Attachment C :</b> This form has changed from the past format and now excludes the preconstruction fee line item. In this new format, should the design/builder put its costs for the preconstruction phase in general conditions (staff and related costs) or in the fee line item? In addition, the contract form Article 6 references preconstruction fee, its components and compensation. How will this be addressed in the event that no preconstruction-specific fee is identified?	Please see Section B.14.1 of the RFP.
14		<b>Attachment G:</b> We did not see a bid bond amount specified in the RFP. Please clarify.	5% of the bid price.
15		<b>Attachment I:</b> Page 2 of the Subcontracting Plan form notes that for design-build projects the SBE subcontracting plan is not required to be submitted for preconstruction services; - however a full plan is required prior to execution of the GMP. That would indicate that this form is to be completed after award of a contract. Please clarify what if any portion of this form must non-SBE/CBE firms complete and include with the proposal.	The subcontracting plan is not required until the GMP is submitted.
