




82% of respondents between the ages 25-49

35% households have children currently at Ketcham ES or attending in the next 3 years




6. Do you have a child that currently attends Ketcham Elementary School or will be attending Ketcham Elementary School within the next three years? (select yes or no)










# **CONCEPT FLOOR PLAN**
