# PROJECT UPDATE: MARCH 2023

### PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Crestwood Triangle Park renovation and improvements include:

- Preserve Existing Trees and Natural Elements
- Preserve Open Space for gathering and events
- Nature-Inspired Play Spot
- Improve the grass in the park (power-tilled overseeding per UFD)
- New Tree Plantings
- ADA access
- New Site Furnishings and Signage

# **PROJECT TIMELINE:**

- Outreach and Survey: 2020
- Survey Results: 2021
- Design Begins: 2022
- Final Design: February 2023
- Permits: Spring-Summer 2023Construction Begins: Early Fall 2023
- Construction Complete: Late Fall 2023

## WHAT HAPPENED THIS WINTER:

- The final concept design was shared with the community.
- The extents of the play spot was spray painted and flagged for the community to visualize

# WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE COMING MONTHS:

- The permit set of drawings will be submitted to the Department of Building (DOB).
- Archaeologists will be taking soil samples on or around March 13<sup>th</sup> (weather dependent)
- The construction start date will be shared with the community about a month in advance once this date has been confirmed.
