2	The solicitation states on page 3 of 54, Section B.6.2 "Attachment J.12: Service Contract Act U.S. DOL Wage Determination No.: 2015-4281, Revision No.:8, dated 26-December-2017", however it appears that the attachment published is Revision 11. Which version should bidders be referencing for Wage Determination?	Please see Addendum No. 02 Item, No. 02.
3	The solicitation states on page 35 of 54, Under #1 Commercial General Liability Insurance references 2,000,000 general aggregate seems a little aggressive for this type and size of contract and may, unintentionally, eliminate small disadvantaged companies from bidding on this solicitation. Please reconsider the \$2,000,000 general aggregate requirement to a more common and well protected \$1,000,000 general aggregate.	All insurance provisions are stipulated and governed by the District of Columbia Office of Risk Management and DGS will not consider revising.
4	The solicitation does not reference or infer to the requirement for data migration (i.e., copying user profile information from the old pc to the new). As such, it would be assumed that the user profile data is automatically stored on the agency server. Please confirm whether data migration should be included in the installation requirements of the solicitation.	Please see Addendum No. 02, Item No. 04
