The Ward 8 Short-term Family Housing building will open and begin serving 50 families this Fall.

June 2018 Construction Update:

- Podium steel erection completed.
- Modules erection has begun.
- Interior framing has begun.
- Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing (MEP) rough-in has begun.

July 2018 Construction Activity:

- Modular erection continues (three full floors completed as of July 17th).
- Roof installation begins.
- Site utility connections continue.

Community Advisory:

- A new Traffic Control Plan (TCP) was approved closing the west lane of traffic (on the side of the street nearest the building) starting approximately 100 feet north of the project site and extending to the south approximately 600 feet from 3:00am to 4:00pm for delivery of the modules. This TCP will remain in effect until all modules are delivered.
