The exact number of fluorescent fixtures are located on Attachment A -Revised Bid Form and can be viewed on Attachment E , Electrical Drawings. Potential Offeror's can visit the King Greenleaf Recreation Center if needed.
2	Do we need to spec in the new ballast/drivers or do we need to spec with the original ballast/driver? If we are required to install new ballasts/driver how do we enter the cost on the bid form?	DGS's recommends the use of LEDs with internal drivers that will not require new ballasts.
3	Official sources at DCSEU have indicated that there are ample rebate funds, do you still expect us to subtract it from the total costs?	Yes, DGS does expect the rebate cost savings to be reflected in the Bid Form.
4	Can you provide us with suggested color temperatures for all of the lighting you would like to have retrofitted for this project?	Please see Attachment B - Revised Bid Form, column F.
5	Please provide clarification on the following: the connectors appear to be 4 pin CFL styles	If the current CFL connector is a 4 pin style, then the LED equivalent should also be a 4 pin style.
	Are the connectors going to be changed to accommodate the LED Bulbs?	LEDs can be directly connected to the line by bypassing the ballasts or removing the ballast altogether.
