> Overview

The District of Columbia Government (the "District"), acting by and through its Department of General Services ("DGS" or the "Department"), Division of Contracts and Procurement, collectively the "District", issues this Invitation for Bids ("IFB") to engage multiple Small Business Enterprise ("SBE") firms to provide on an as-needed basis HVAC filters, HEPA filters, HVAC and Boiler supplies, materials & equipment to support operational needs for the Boiler Plant Operations Division ("BPO"). All supplies, materials and equipment shall be furnished in accordance with the Scope of Work Section [C] of this Invitation for Bid ("IFB" or "Solicitation"), the Department's Standard Contract Provisions ('SCP") for Supplies and Services Contracts, January 2016 Exhibit E.1, and other associated contract exhibits, and solicitation attachments listed in Section [J] of this IFB and the proposed Contract.

Type of Contract

Pursuant to the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Reform Act ("PPRA") 2010, Section 402 Competitive Sealed Bids, and in accordance with Title 27 DCMR, Chapter 47 "Department of General Services Procurement Rules for Construction and Related Services." Sections 4715 "Term Contract", Title 27 DCMR, Section 2416, the District contemplates award of multiple Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity ("ID/IQ") Contracts with services compensated on a fixed-price basis in accordance with Title 27 DCMR Chapter 24, 2404 Fixed-Price Contracts.





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- Time is of the essence with respect to the contract. As such, it is the District's expectation that the contractor dedicate such personnel and other resources as are necessary to ensure that the required services are completed on time and in a diligent, skilled, and professional manner to be completed by the contract end date.
- Before submitting its bid in response to the proposed Contract, the Bidder(s) acknowledges that it reviewed the proposed contract and all exhibits/attachments and is required to bring all such inconsistencies and or questions to the attention of the Department so that the Department can address any inconsistencies and or questions by addendum to this solicitation. The Contractor acknowledges that any inconsistencies and or questions it identifies after submitting its bid shall not be the basis for a change to the Contract terms and conditions.

Bidders should take care to review the **ENTIRE** IFB solicitation document, assuring its full understanding of the District's expectations and terms & conditions. Contractors will **<u>not</u>** be relieved from assuming all responsibility for properly estimating the difficulties and the cost of performing the services required herein due to their failure to investigate the conditions, or to become fully acquainted with all information, schedules and liability concerning the services to be performed as provided by the District.

If a prospective Bidder has any questions relating to this solicitation, the prospective Bidder shall submit the question via the Vendor Submission Portal to the attention of Contract Specialist, Ashley Willis. The prospective Bidder should submit questions no later than *Friday, June 23, 2023*. The Department will furnish responses via addenda issued to the solicitation and posted to the Department's Solicitation Web page found at https://dgs.dc.gov/page/dgs-solicitations. An addenda to the solicitation will be issued only if the CO decides that information is necessary in submitting offers, or if the lack of it would be prejudicial to any prospective Bidder. Oral explanations or instructions given by Department officials before the award of the Contract will not be binding.





> SECTION L.1

The Government will evaluate bids in response to this solicitation without discussions and will award a contract to the responsible bidders whose bids, conforming to the solicitation, will be most advantageous to the Government considering only price and the price-related factors specified elsewhere in the solicitation. The Government may:

- (1) Reject any or all bids.
- (2) Accept other than the lowest bid.
- (3) Waive informalities or minor irregularities in bids received.
- (4) The Government may reject a bid as nonresponsive if a bid is materially unbalanced when it is based on prices significantly less than cost for some work and prices which are significantly overstated in relation to cost for other work, and if there is a reasonable doubt that the bid will result in the lowest overall cost to the Government even though it may be the low evaluated bid, or if it is so unbalanced as to be tantamount to allowing an advance payment.

The District intends award multiple Contracts resulting from this solicitation to Contractors who present the overall lowest bids who are responsive and responsible bidders and are deemed reasonable in accordance with price realism evaluation principles.

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BID PRICE AND BID FORM

The firm-fixed price per item identified herein shall be the Contractor's sole method of compensation and as such, shall be (i) fully-loaded and firm for the life of the Contract, and (ii) sufficient to cover all of the service requirements including, but not limited to, HVAC filters, HEPA filters, supplies, materials & equipment, labor, trade, subcontractor cost, home office cost, G&A (general and administrative expenses), insurance coverage provisions as required by Section [I.14]. As such, the Contract Price shall include all increases for the base and option periods in its original Bid as well as all applicable year-over-year service cost increases due to market variables and any increase to the applicable labor categories, direct hourly rates required by the U.S. Department of Labor Service Contract Act Wage Determination and or the D.C. Living Wage Act of 2006 (whichever prevailing wage is applicable under the award of the Contract for the Base Period and any subsequent Option Periods) and, all else necessary to fulfill the services level agreement for providing the District efficient and economical provision of required services as described herein. In no event shall the item prices exceed the contractor's sales price to its most-favored customer for the same items in like quantities, or the current market price, whichever is lower.

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DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE PACKAGE

- ✓ Descriptive literature must be furnished as a part of a bid and must be received before the time set for opening bids.
- ✓ Failure of descriptive literature to show that the product offered conforms to the specifications and other requirements of this invitation for bids may require rejection of the bid.
 - A. Bidder states in the bid that the product being offered is the same as a product previously or currently being furnished to the District; or
 - B. The CO, on advice of technical personnel determines that the product offered by the bidder complies with the specification requirements of the current invitation for bids.

The Descriptive Literature documents shall <u>not</u> include any markings or representations of the Bidder's name or firm or otherwise identifiable information for the purpose of anonymous review by the Departments technical representative.





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The Compliance Package <u>must be</u> organized and prepared as follows: The Bidder shall complete in their entirety the following compliance documents and submit as a complete package:
