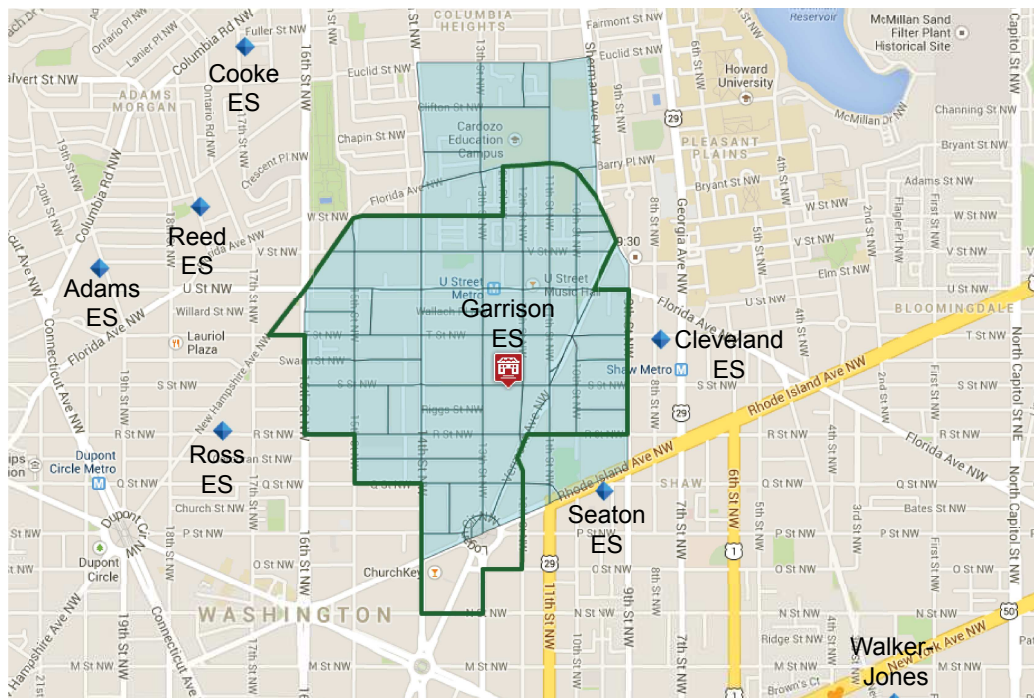

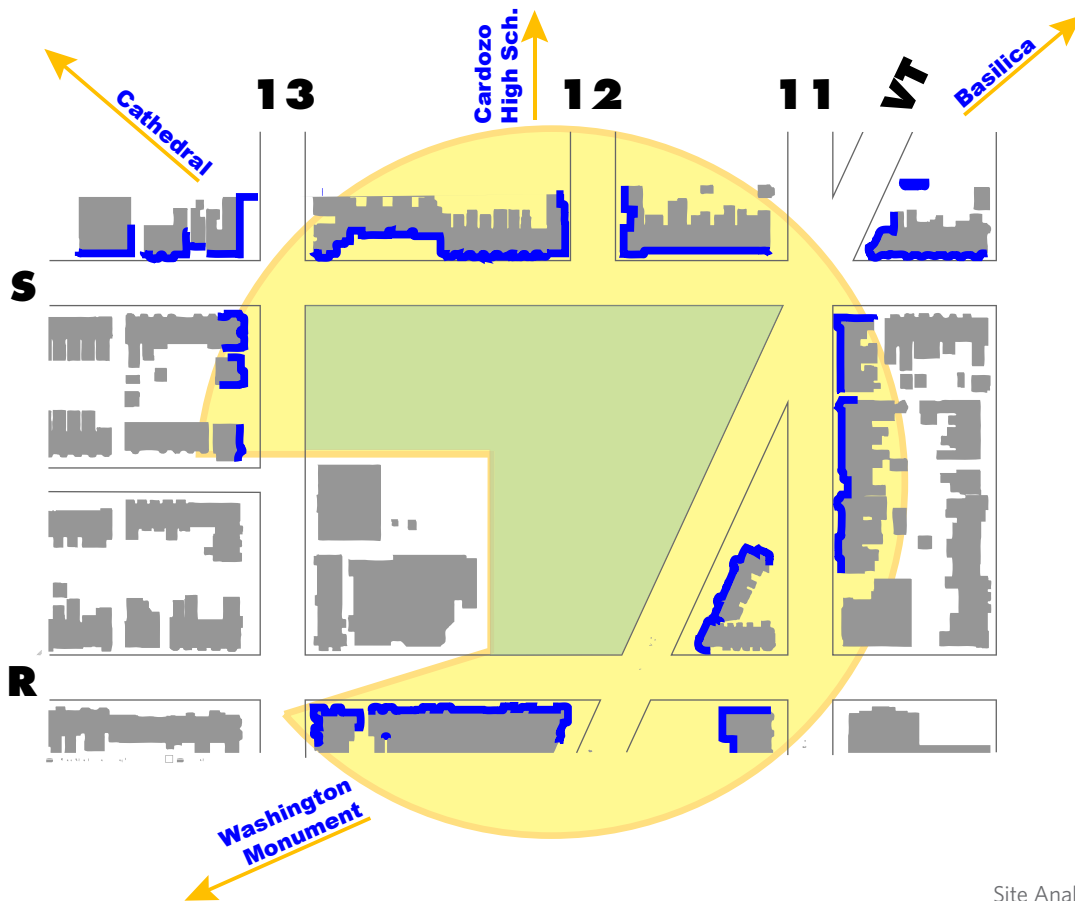


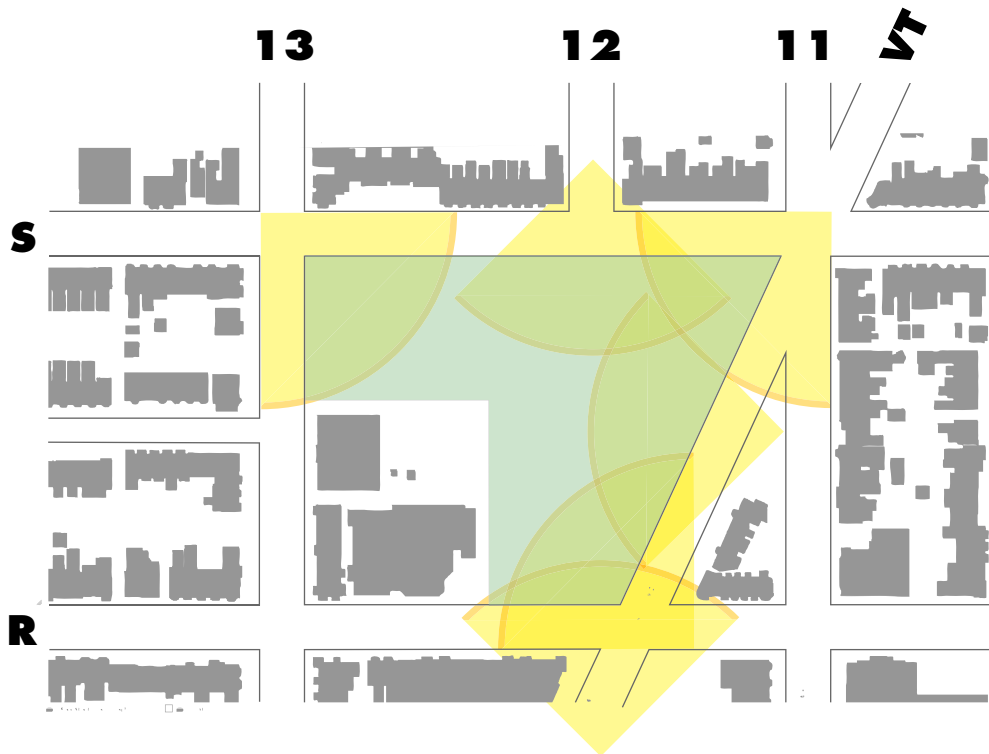
Site Analysis **School Boundaries**



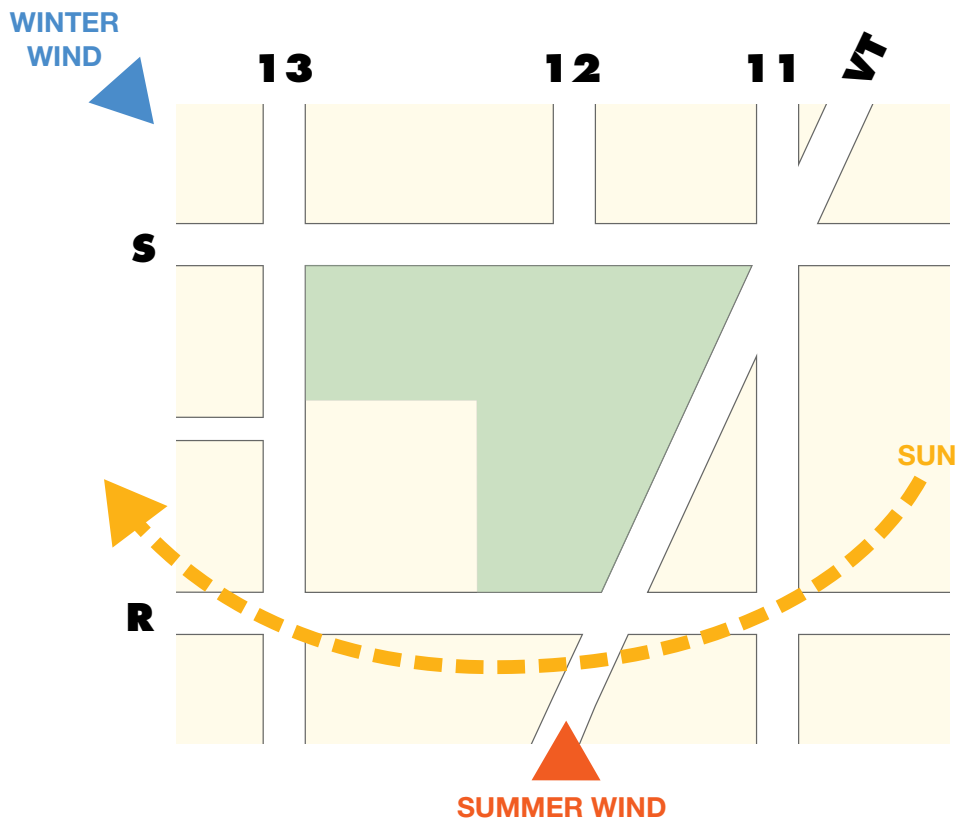


## Site Analysis Adjacent Land Use

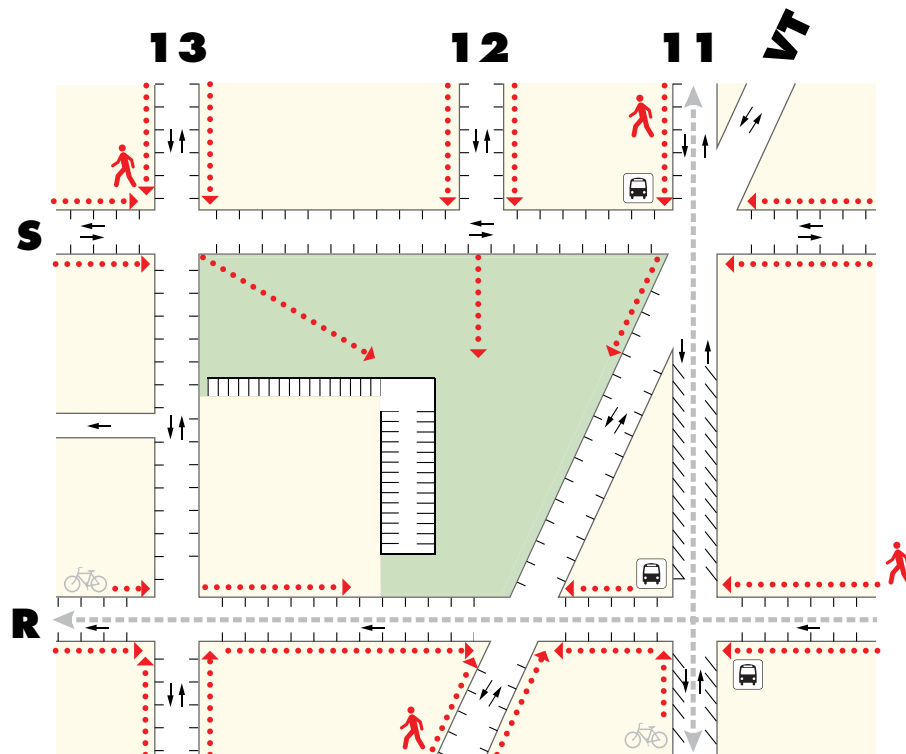


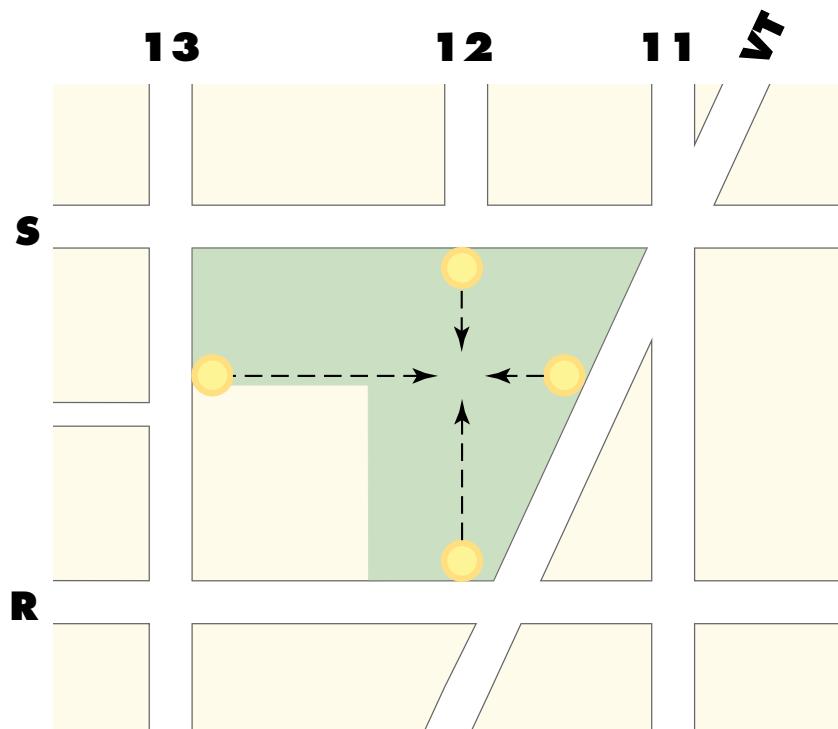
