

Gather

 A central gathering space with connections to all areas of the park.

Play

- Regrading and improvement of the current field.
- · Existing Splashpad is to be renovated.
- · New playground equipment.

Learn

- Flexible field area with bioretention, wildflowers or other plantings.
- Walking path to provide visual interest and learning opportunities.
- Potential to add additional pollinator or rainwater gardens along the west edge of the play area.





