HARDY PARK

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: APRIL 2021

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Hardy Park project includes design and construction of an additional enclosed room at the recreation center, a new playground, a new splashpad, the renovation of the existing soccer field with a lower playing field, a new picnic plaza and pavilion, a walking track around the field with fitness equipment, a new dogpark, remediation of site drainage, runoff and erosion issues. The Project will also include landscaping, fencing, site furnishings amenities and signage.

PROJECT TIMELINE:

Design and Outreach: Spring 2019

Construction Begins: Fall 2020

Park Renovations Begin: Winter 2020

Project Completion: Summer 2021

WHAT HAPPENED THIS WINTER:

- Enclosure of the outdoor porch at the recreation center
- Park permits were obtained
- Tree Protection measures were put into place
- · Stormwater measures were put in place
- Construction Fencing was installed
- Installation of the Park Utilities for water and electrical
- Rough Grading of the Park has started
- The Dog Park has been excavated
- The old playground was removed
- The new playground has begun to be installed
- The demolition of the old splash pad began

WHAT TO EXPECT IN APRIL:

- The new playground will continue to be installed
- The dog park will receive a drainage system
- The sidewalks and trails will start to be installed
- The athletic field grading will continue
- The concrete and steel for the park pavilion will begin
- The old splash pad will be demolished
- · The utilities for the splash pad will be installed
