HEARST PARK AND POOL

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: MARCH 2021

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Hearst Park & Pool includes design and construction of two brand new tennis courts with a practice wall, the renovation of the existing soccer field, a new pool and pool house, remediation of site drainage, runoff and erosion issues. The Project will also include landscaping, fencing, site furnishings, amenities, signage, and pathways.

PROJECT TIMELINE:

- Design and Outreach: May 2016Construction Begins: August 2019
- Phase I of Playground: Fall 2019
- Phase II of Playground: Spring 2020
- Project Completion of the Field and Park: Spring 2021 and will open in late Spring 2021
- Project Completion of the Pool and Poolhouse: Summer 2021

WHAT HAPPENED IN FEBRUARY/MARCH:

- Installed a sump pump that temporarily drains into storm sewer
- · Start the pool excavation
- Pour the concrete roof decks of the pool house
- · Complete the retaining wall above the field
- Installation of some of the paths around the soccer field
- Spread topsoil and graded most of the soccer field
- · Laid the sod on most of the soccer field
- · Pour concrete walk to the recreation center
- Installed block walls on the second floor of the pool house
- Waterproofing of the retaining walls complete
- · Rough Plumbing to the pool house complete

WHAT TO EXPECT IN APRIL:

- Install stone veneer on the wall above the pool
- · Backfilling the retaining walls at the pool house
- Continue the pool excavation
- Install retaining walls adjacent to the field
- Excavate for the field bio-retention system
- Install the western edge bio-retention system
- · Installation of the boardwalks around the field
- · Complete grading of the soccer field
- · Lay the remaining sod on the soccer field
