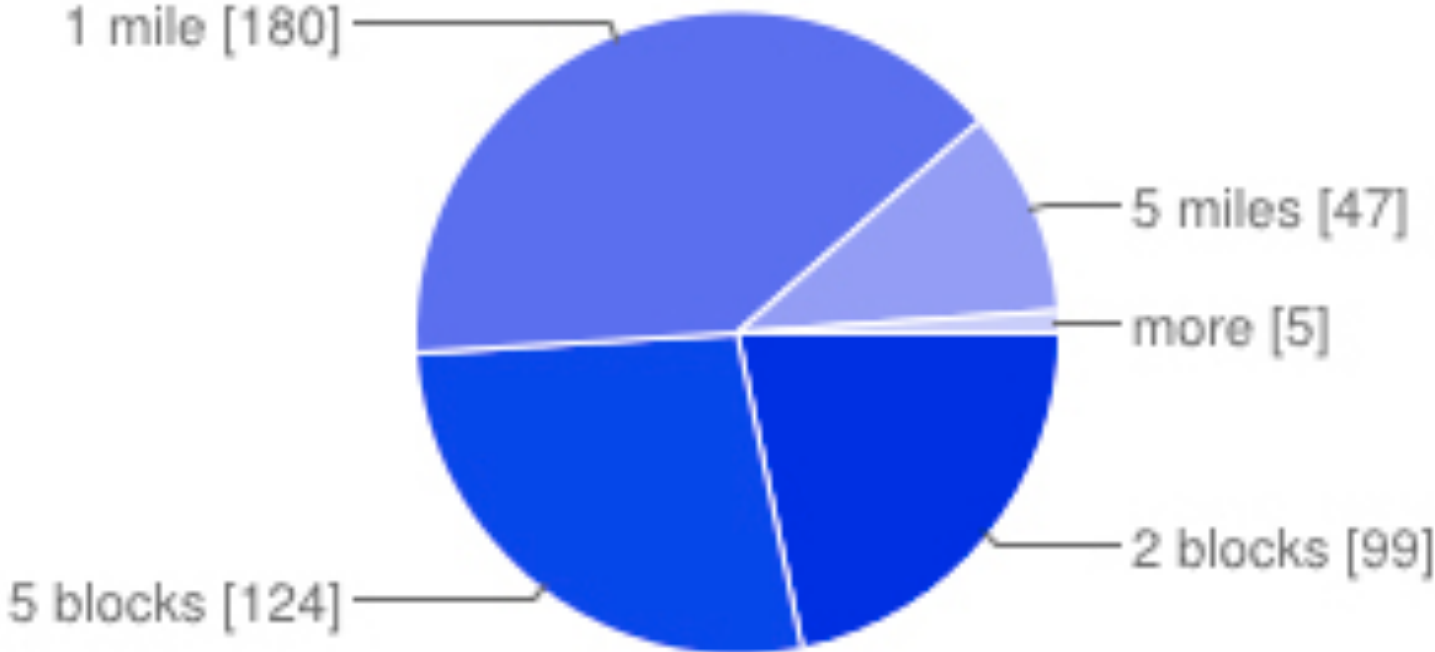

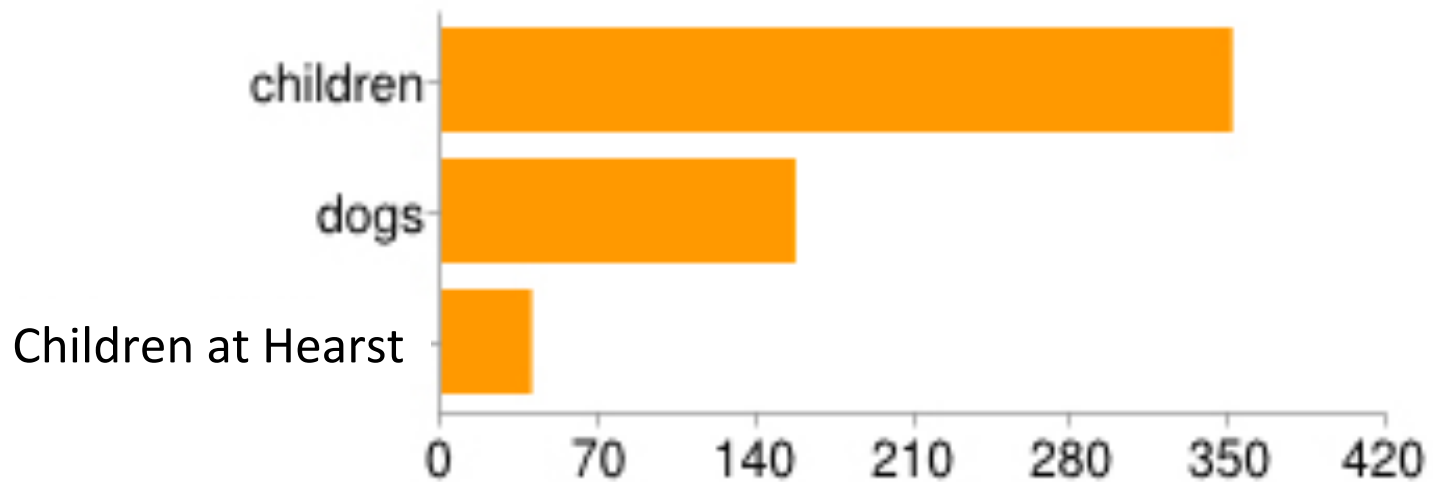

- 459 total responses

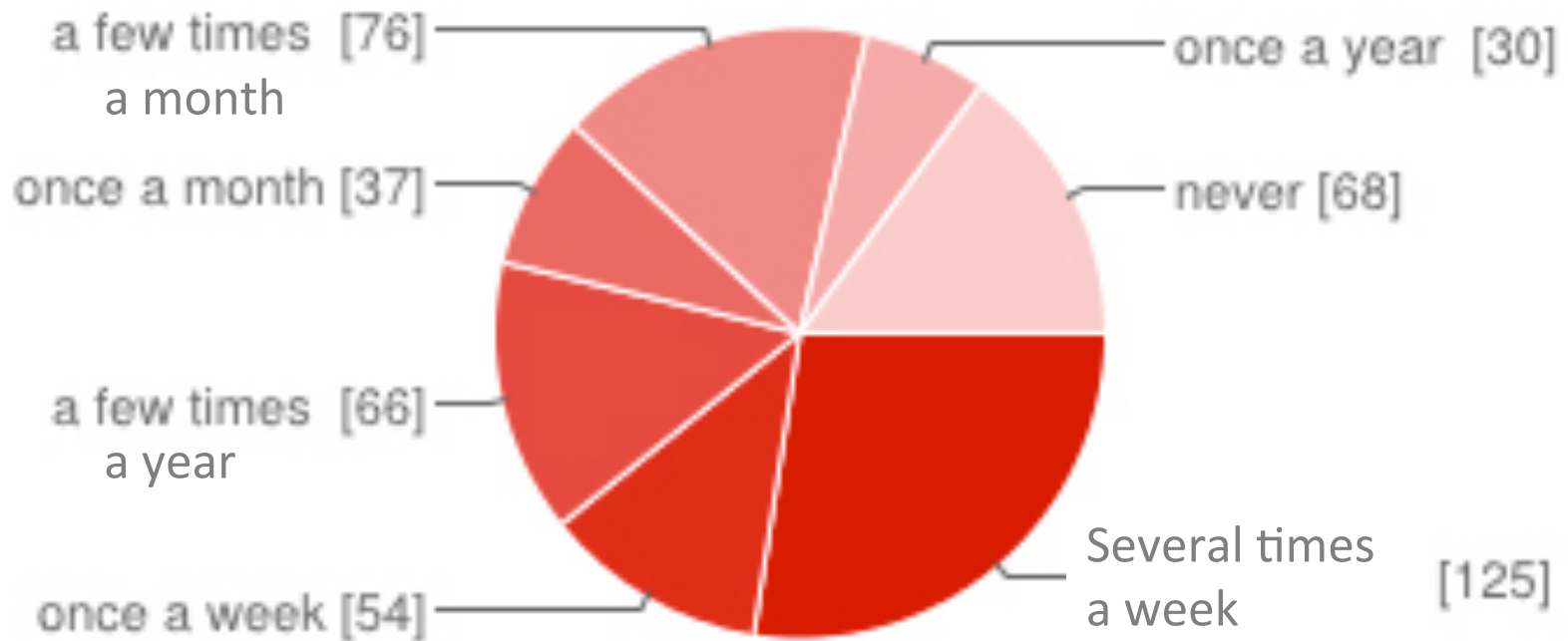
# How close is your residence to Hearst Park?



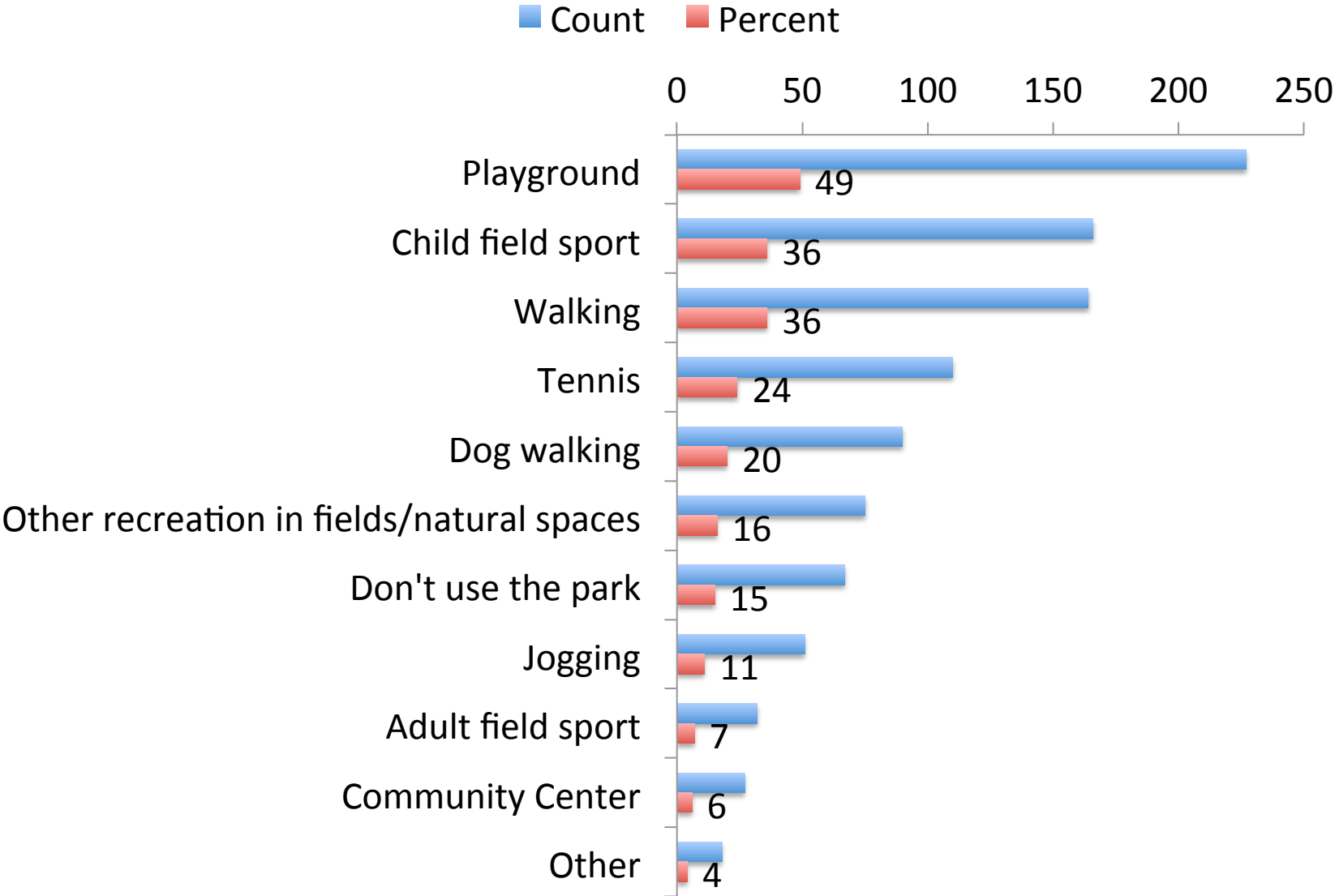
# Do you have any of the following?



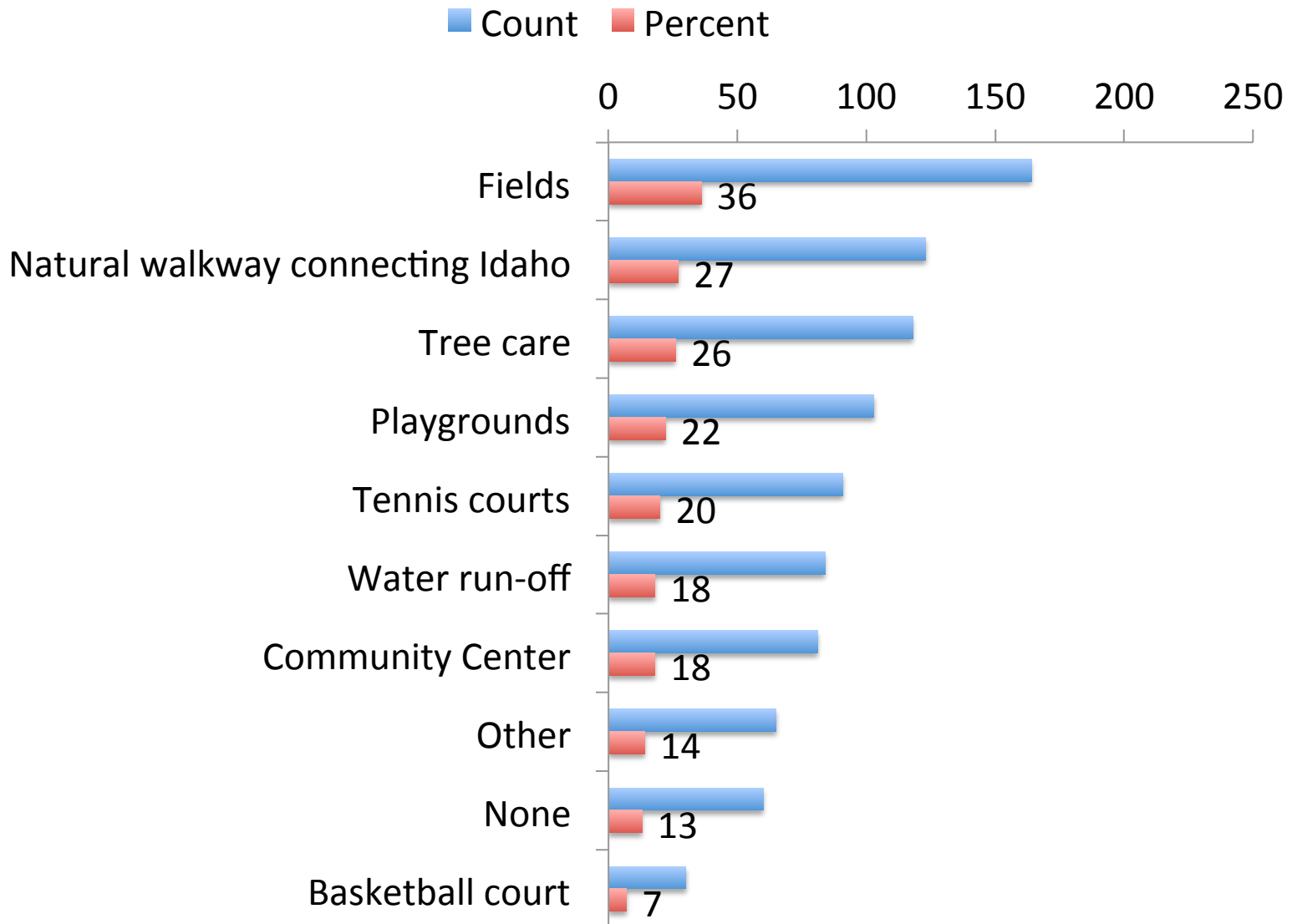
# How often do you use Hearst Park?



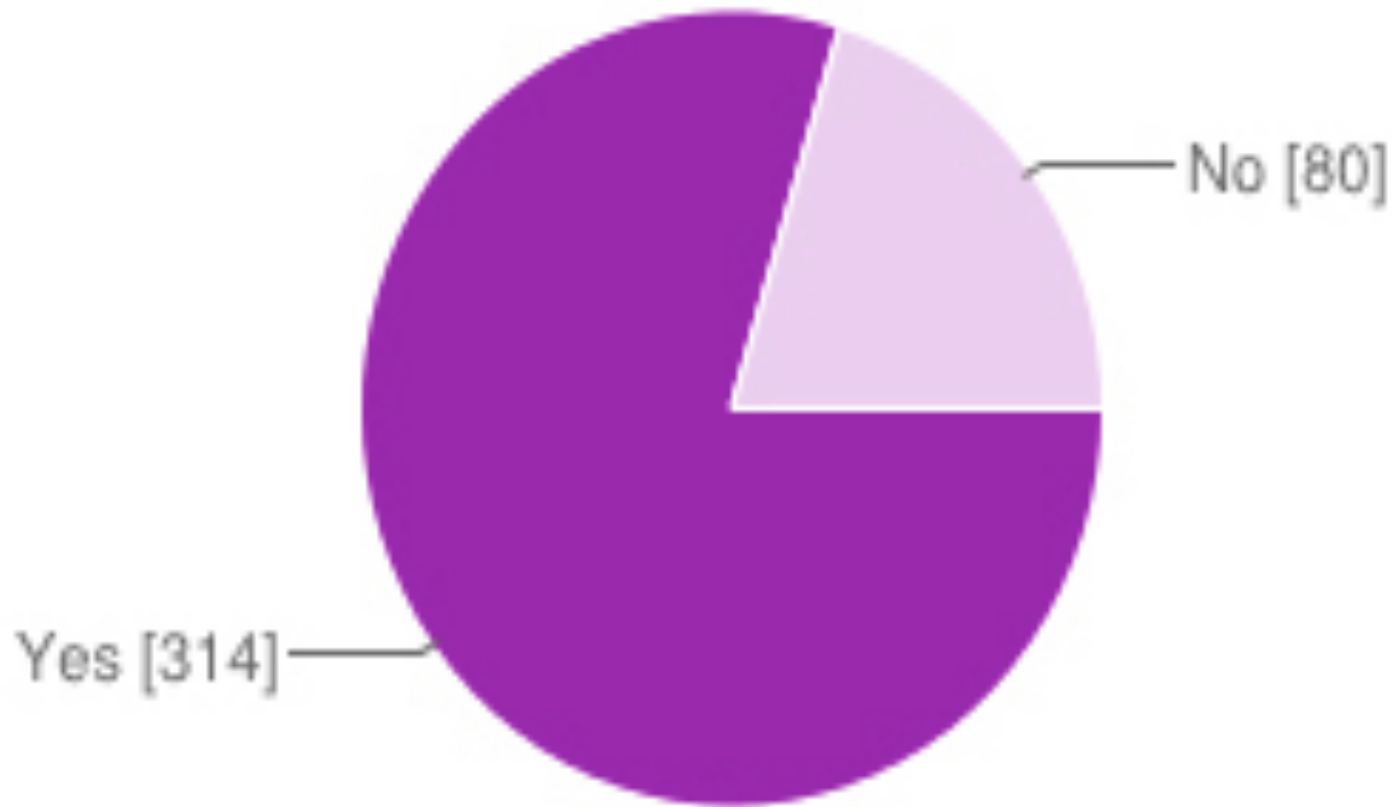
# How do you currently use the park?

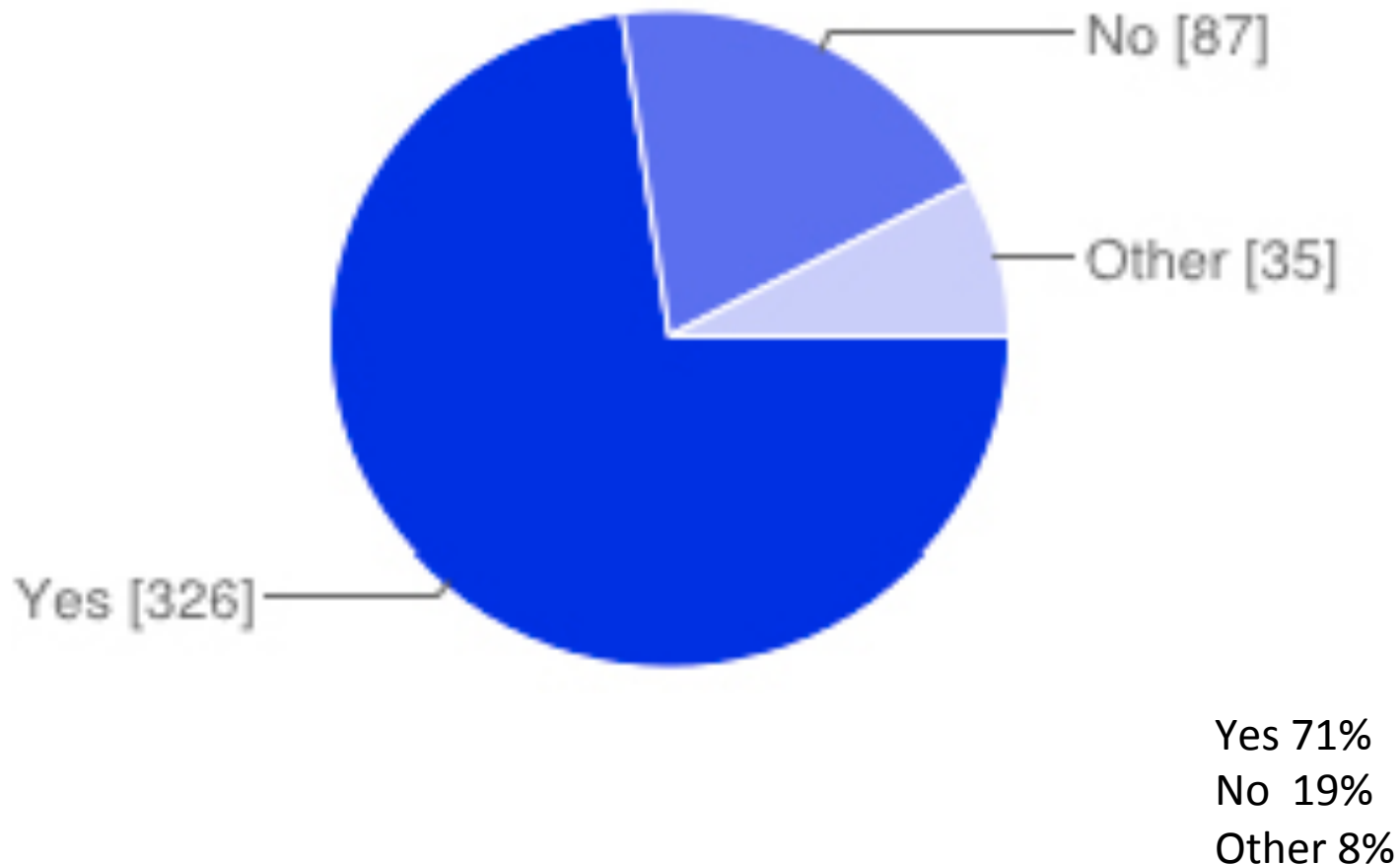


Would you be interested in exploring whether the DC DOT would be able to transfer the Idaho Street right-of-way to DPR so it could be incorporated into Hearst Park?

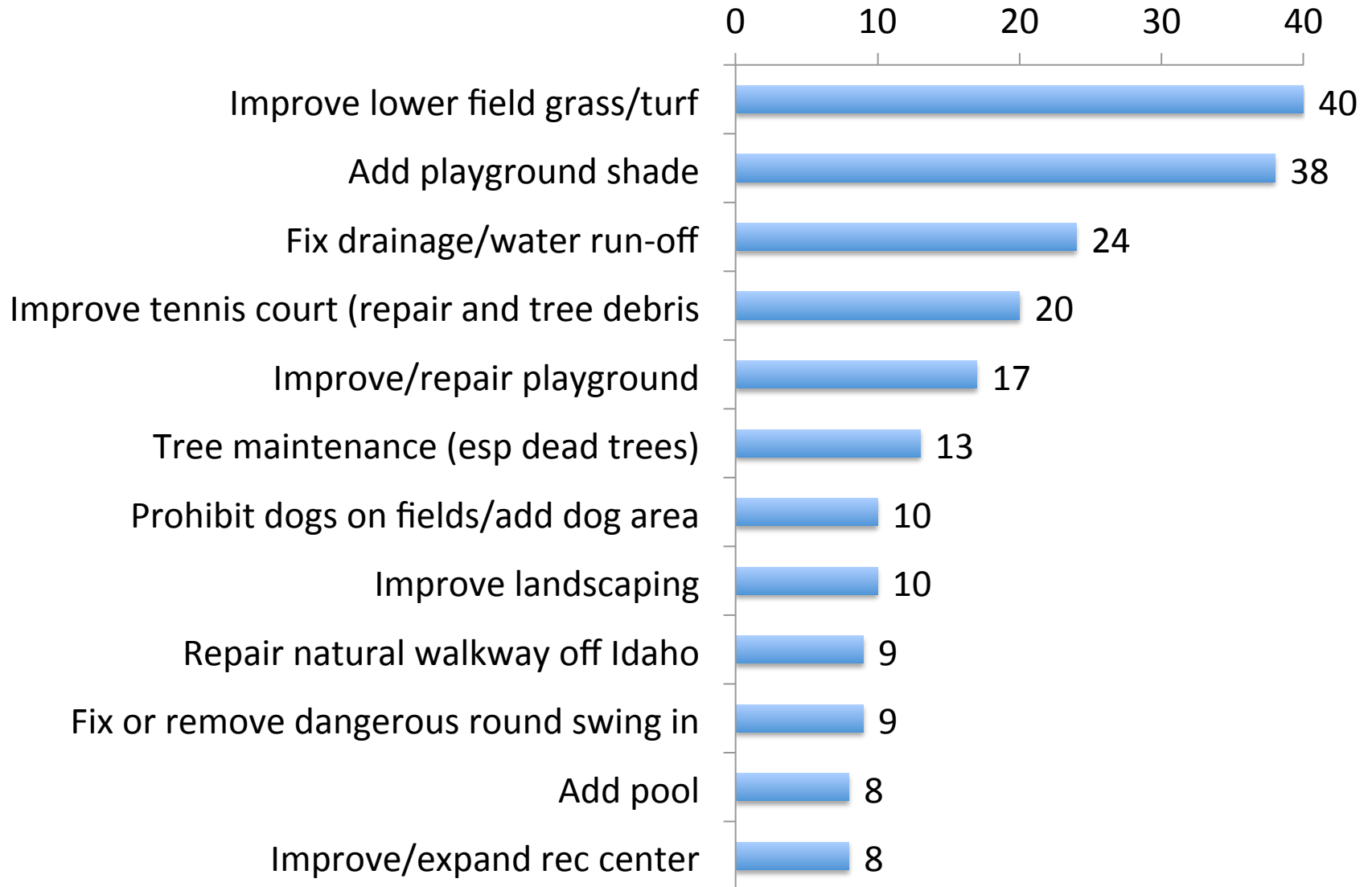




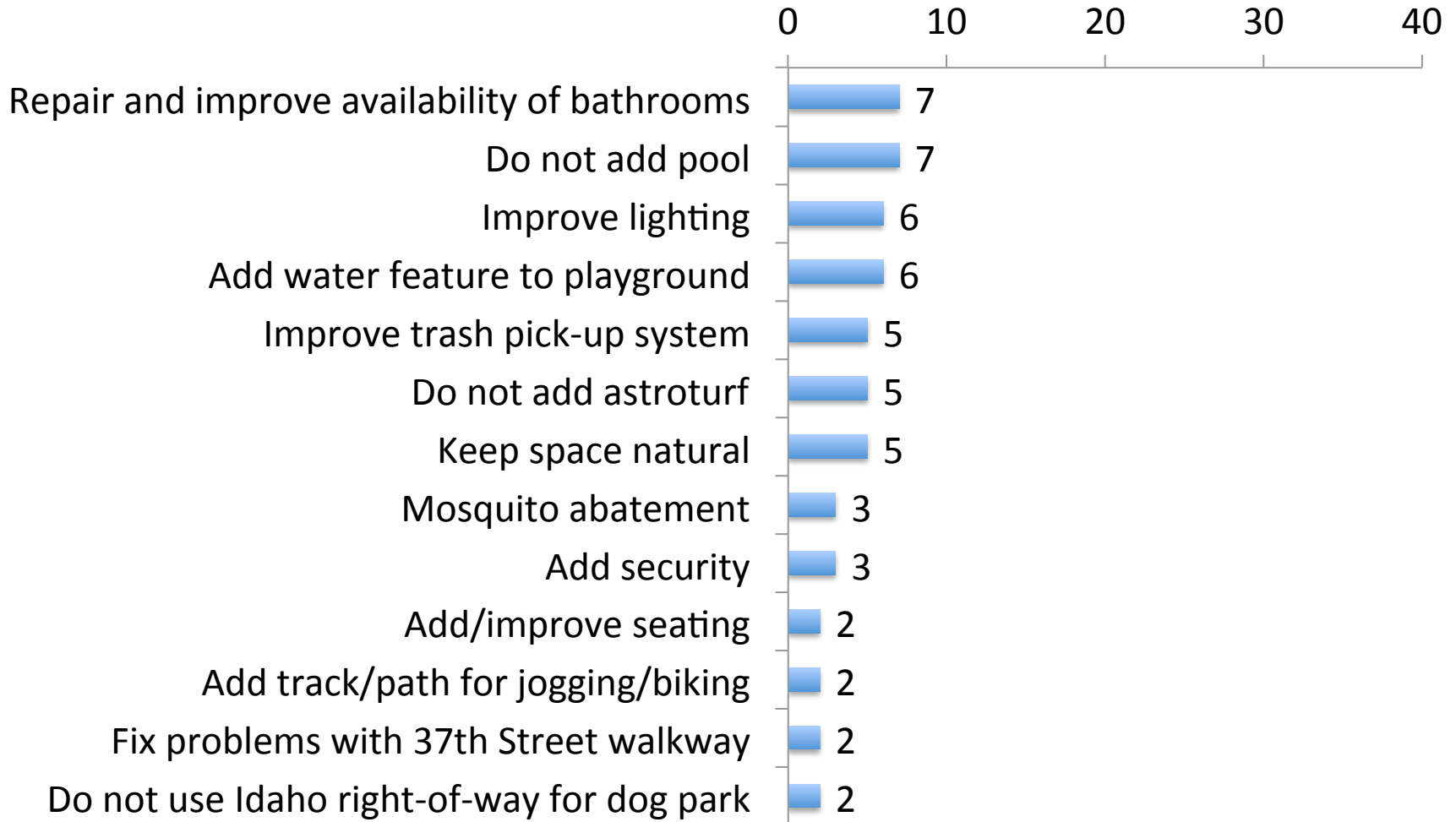
The Council is considering allocating funds for a pool in Ward 3. Would you support the placement of the pool at Hearst Park?



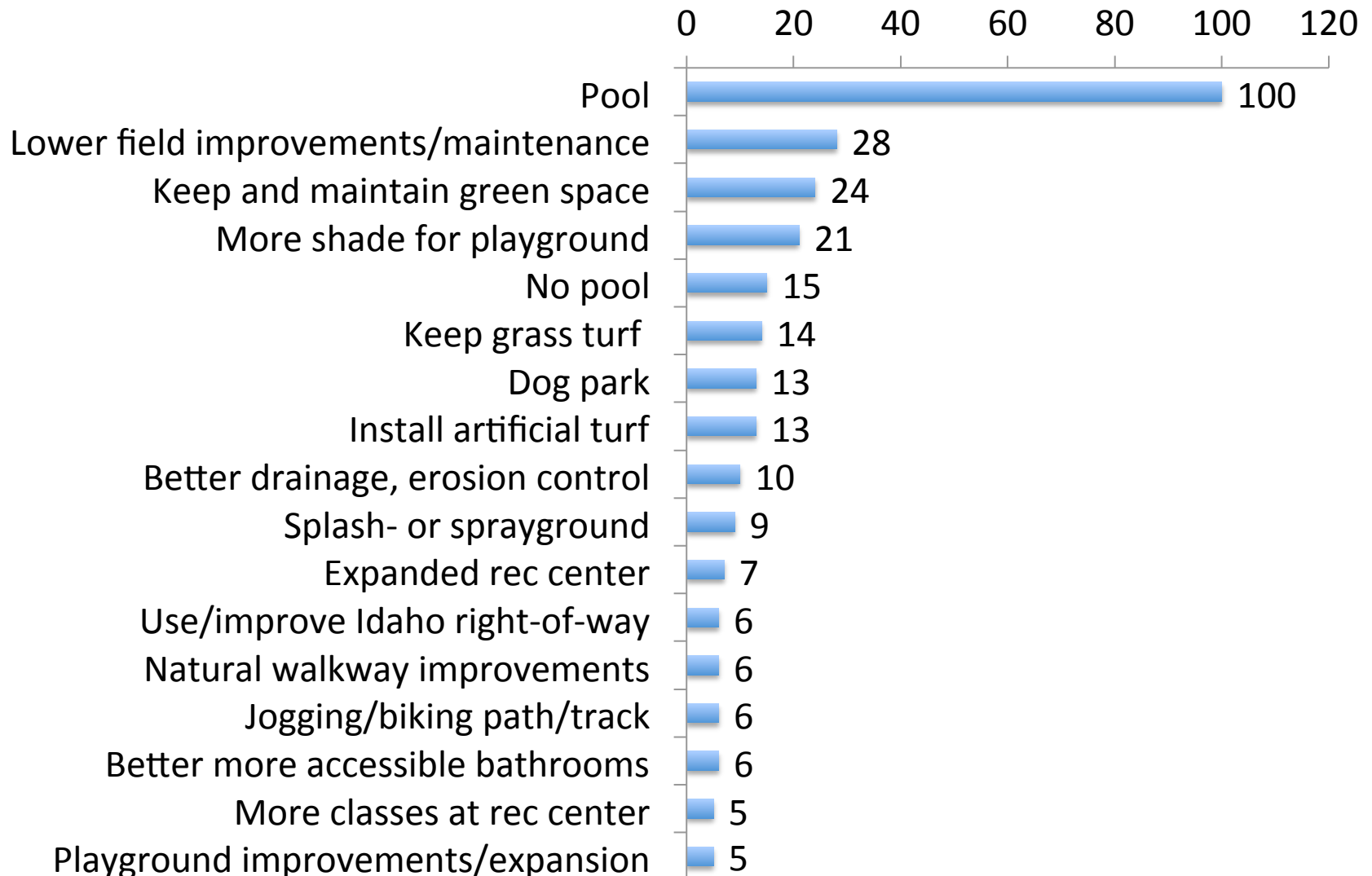
