

Lafayette January 2025 Update

- **Track**
 - **Why is there no replacement?**
 - The track will be replaced and we will work towards completing the track by the end of 2025. This decision was made to avoid multiple instances where students will not have access to the play space as a result of the replacement timeline. DCPS will work closely with the Lafayette administration to ensure the timeline will not hinder students who are members of the track and field team and will not have to look for other locations to practice.
 - **What is the status of the drains?**
 - Some drains that needed to be replaced and repaired not near the track, have been. Approximately 50 linear feet of drains near the track will be repaired or removed and 450 linear feet of new drains will be installed.
- **Field**
 - **What is the status of the Irrigation System?**
 - A third party will work to assess the irrigation system when weather conditions are warmer and we will follow up with the community once we know more.
 - **What is field Maintenance? (if different from athletic field maintenance)**
 - This field will be added to the District's athletic field contract to maintain the field. As mentioned in the public meeting, the field will not be resodded. Routine athletic field maintenance services include mowing, trimming, de-weeding, in-field dragging, and edging.
- **Status of Bioretention bed/fence**
 - The fence along 33rd street bioretention is complete as of November 15, 2024.
- **Maintenance for Grass on 33rd Street**
 - The sod/grass replacement work complete as of October 15, 2024.
