







1. Project Budget

\$4.6M includes:

- new, small, innovative facility that fits within context of the community
- park storm-water management improvements
- bollard style lighting in the park (based on lighting task force's recommendations)
- working water fountains within the park and in the Recreation Center
- ADA accessible restrooms

This project does not include any athletic court lighting.




































SITE PLAN
