Unit #: Sustainable Art: Reduce and Reuse

Overview and Goal of the Lesson: For the duration of this lesson students will able to understand the impact of the excessive use of resources and irresponsible waste of them. Students will then experiment with ways to reuse everyday waste such as packing products, bottles, and old discarded clothing in order to establish a plan to limit their personal impact on the environment.

Essential Question(s): What happens to the goods and products that we waste everyday?

Does the excessive waste that we accumulate here in the US simply affect our environment? or throughout the world? What would be the long-term effects, if any: Should we begin to reuse or repurpose even a small portion of our household waste.

Duration: 3 class days
