## **Project Status:**

- The demolition of the existing retaining wall is ongoing and scheduled to be complete by the end of February
- Sheeting and shoring installation is ongoing and scheduled be completed by the end of February
- Foundation system (Cast Auger Pile) is approximately 50% complete, scheduled to be completed by Mid-March

## **Community Advisory:**

- DGS takes residents' concerns regarding their homes very seriously. To ensure that DGS follows the proper
  procedures related to any such concerns, we reached out to the District's Office of Risk Management
  (DCORM) for their assistance. Based on their guidance, property owners who believe that their properties
  have been negatively affected by the construction must file an official claim with DCORM, as required by

- Dump truck activity to and from the site is ongoing
