Sherwood/School-Within-School Playground Project Project update – July 21, 2014

Brief description of project: The Sherwood/School-Within-School (SWS) Playground Project will bring a new playground to Sherwood Recreation Center and a new parking lot to School-Within-School at Goding Elementary.

Community Engagement:

Project Updates:

- A. DGS awarded a contract to Bennett Paschen Joint Venture to serve as the general contractor. Bennett Paschen mobilized on site beginning June 12, 2014 after a pre-construction community meeting held on June 11, 2014.
- B. Construction substantial completion date: September 2014.
- C. Progress to date:
 - a. Construction fencing installed.
 - b. Tree protection installed.
 - c. Demolition of playground at SWS and half of parking area (to become new playground) at Sherwood.
 - d. Removal of Norway maples and one black gum deemed by the arborist to be in extremely poor condition. The black gum will be replaced with a similarlysized caliper specimen as the playground construction is completed.
 - e. Excavation and grading of new playground area is nearing completion.
 - f. Playground equipment is starting to be delivered to the contractor and installation will begin soon.
- D. Looking ahead: In the next few weeks, you may see the following work occurring:
 - a. Final grading of new playground area, and preparation for safety surfacing.
 - b. Installation of play equipment.
 - c. Re-surfacing of basketball court and installation of additional basketball hoops.
 - d. Milling and striping of the SWS parking lot.

Site Security Update:

It was brought to the attention of DPR, DGS, and DCPS that individuals were entering the construction site after hours. DPR and DGS worked with the contractor to add additional site security mechanisms and to discourage trespassing, such as asking MPD to put additional eyes on the site.
