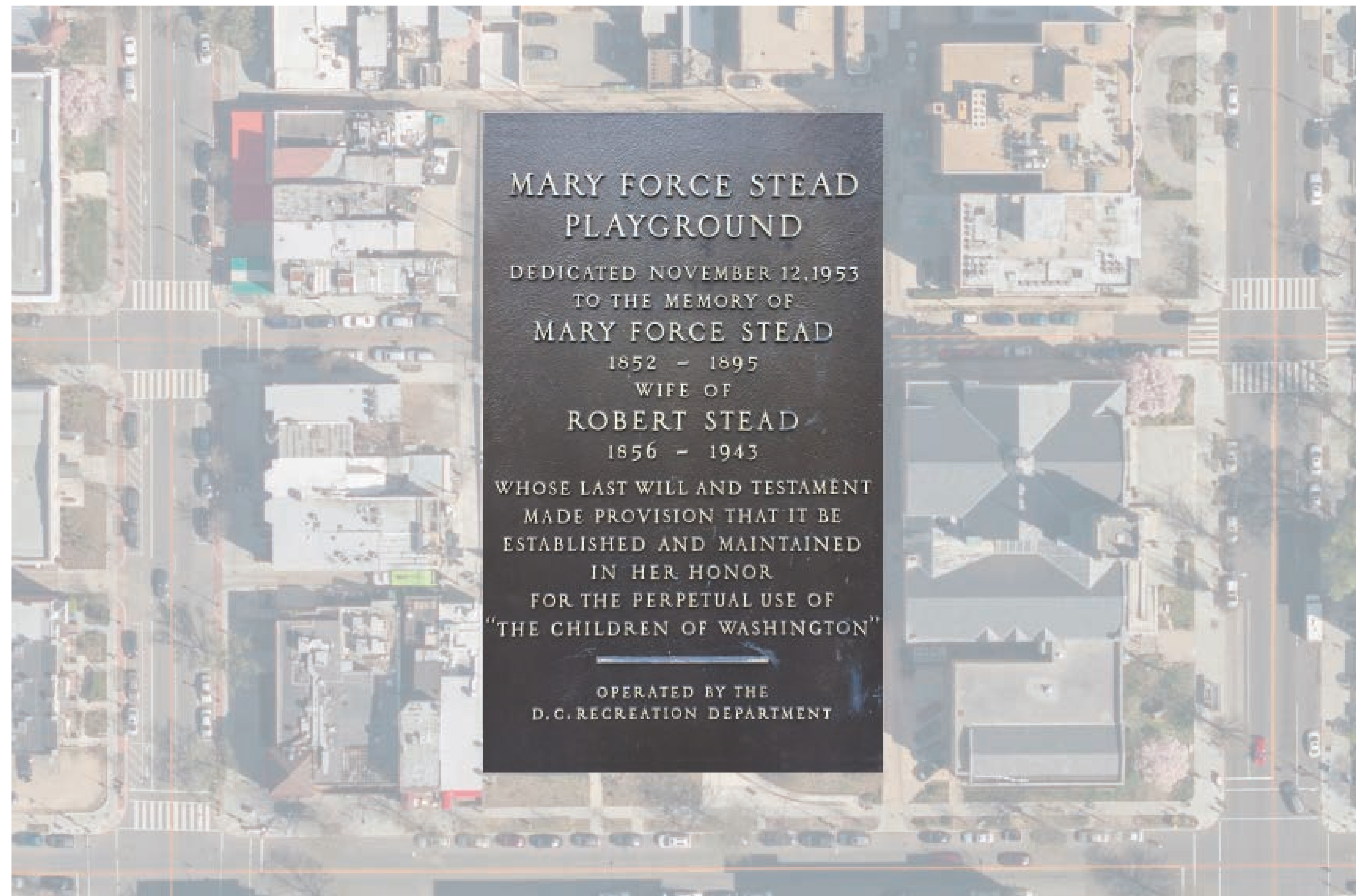

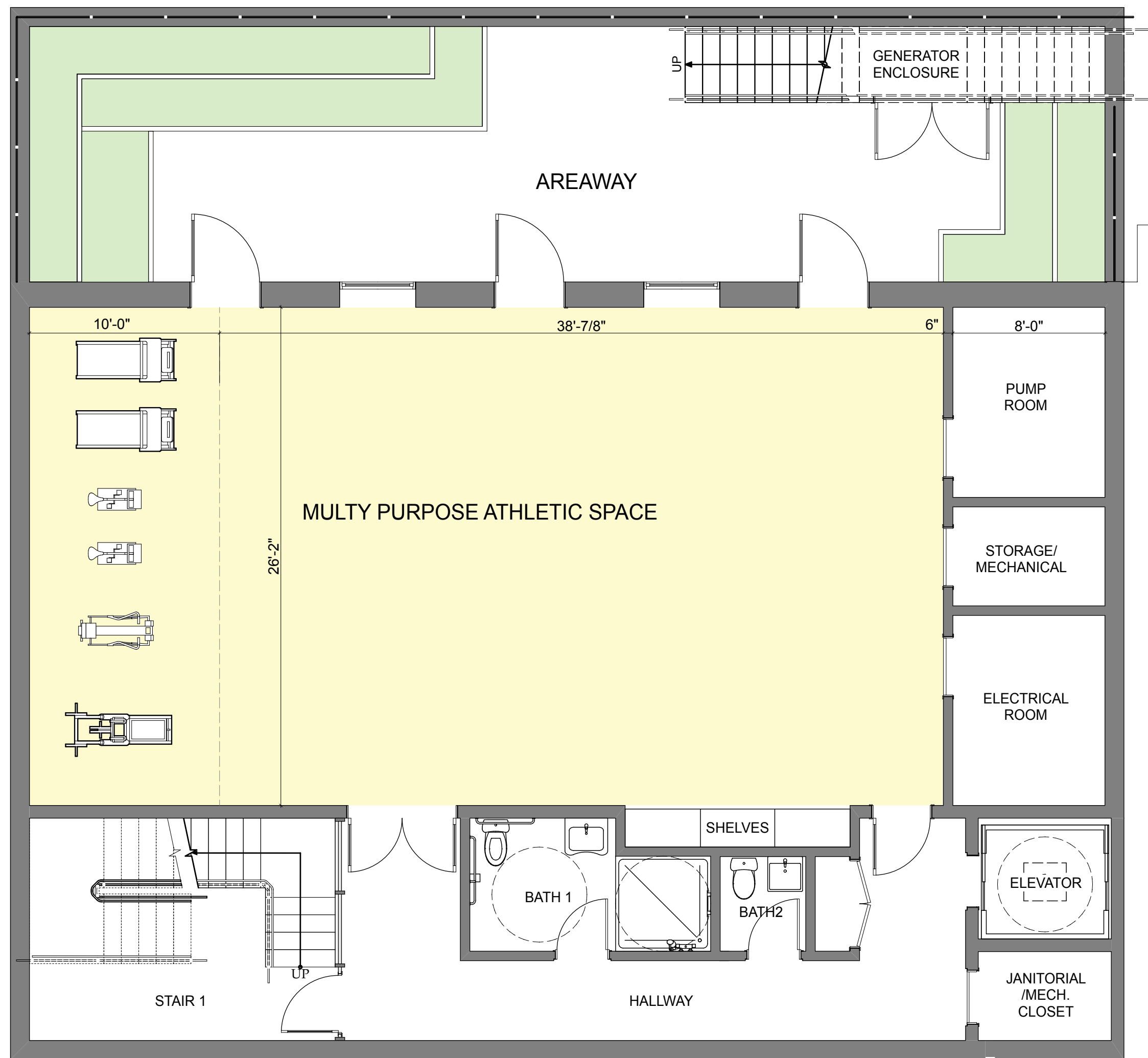

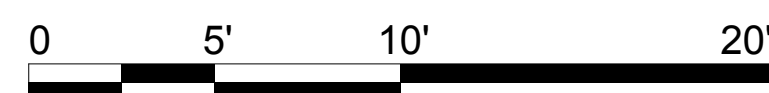
OUTLINE OF BUILDING ABOVE

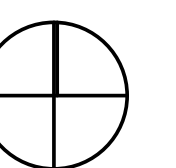

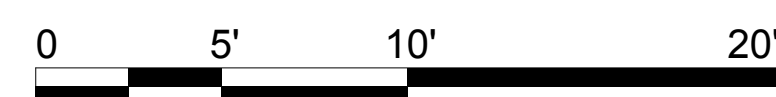

## BASEMENT PLAN



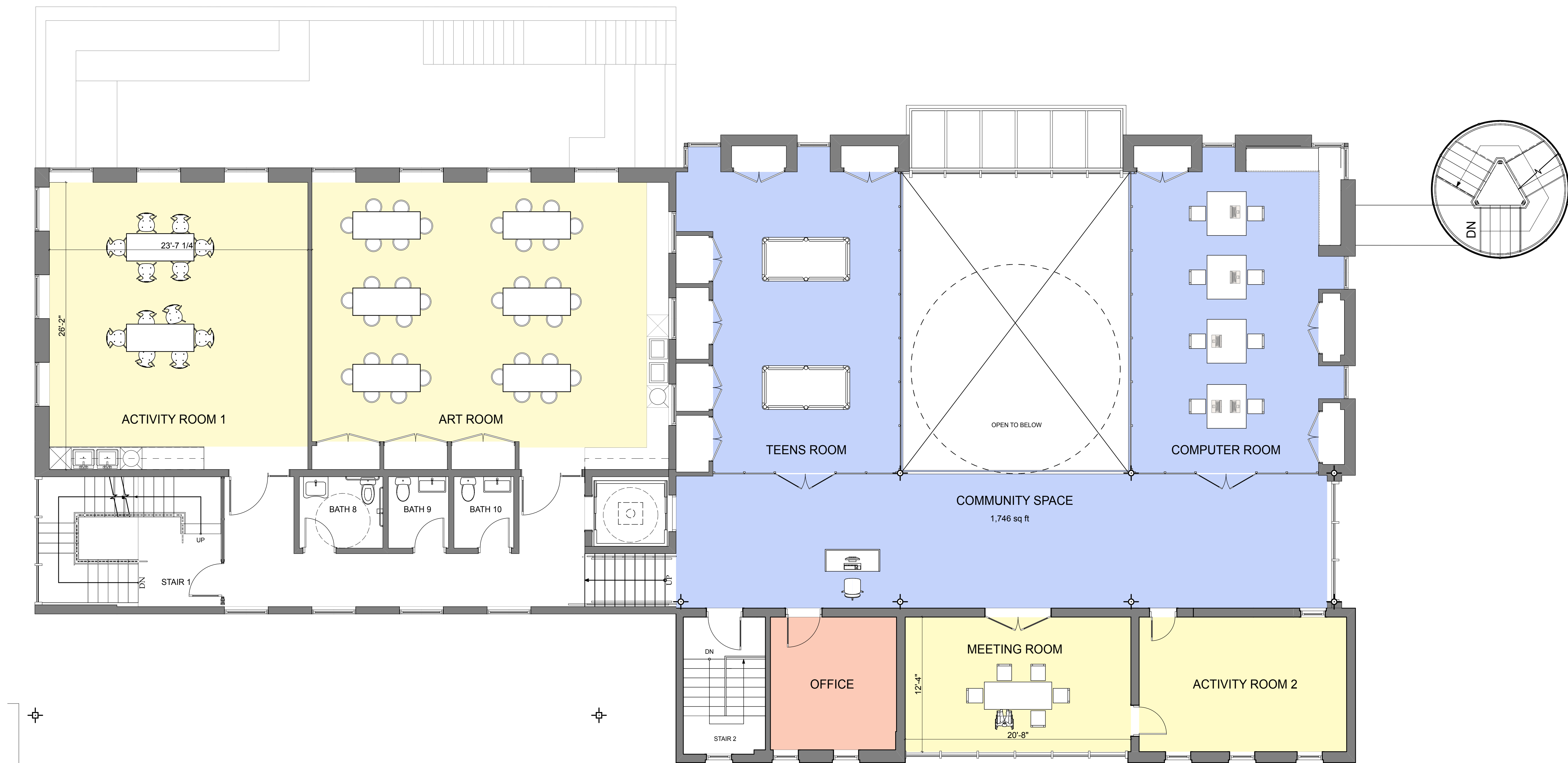

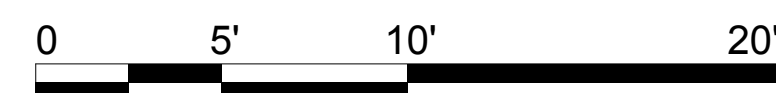

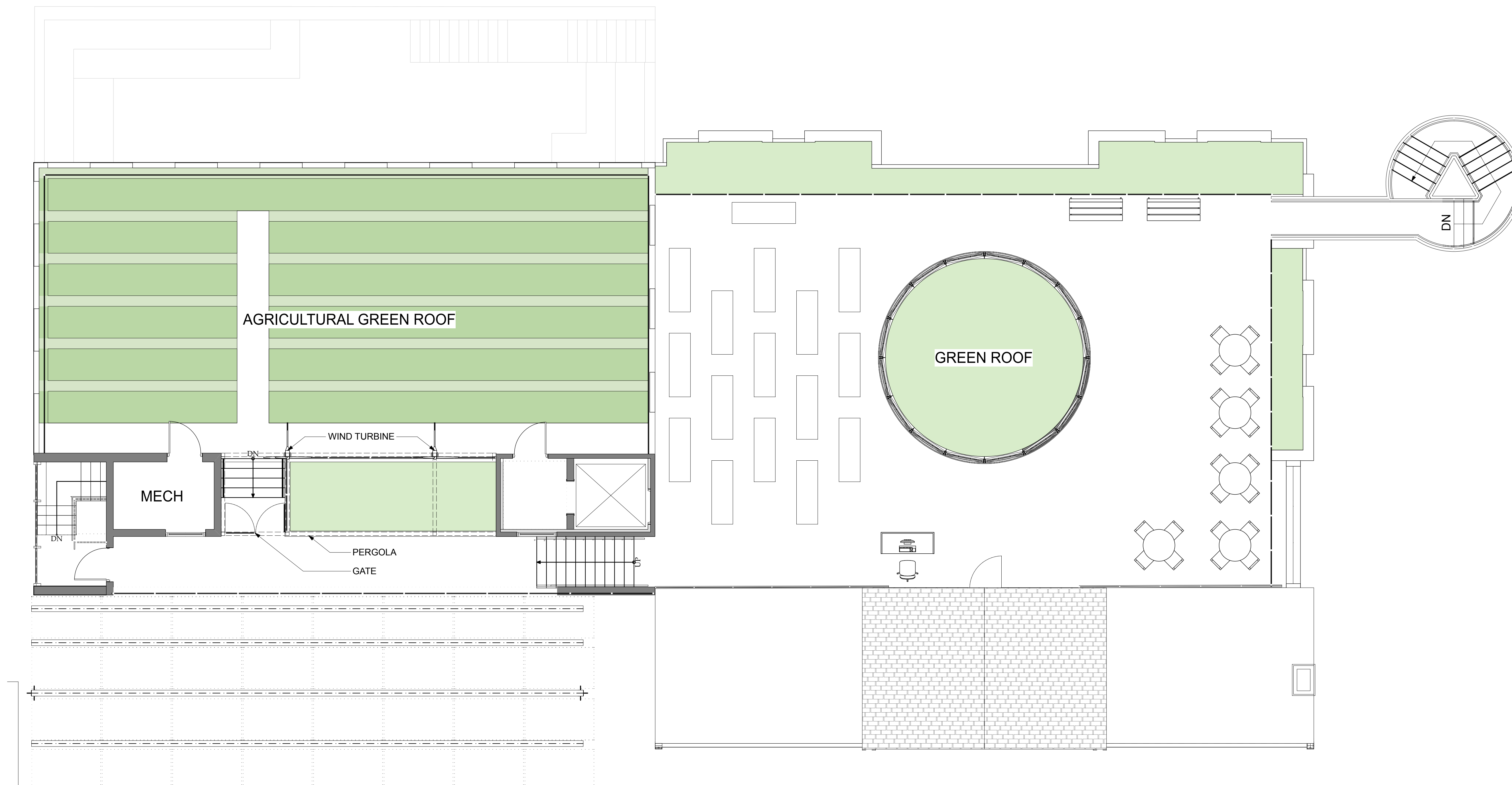

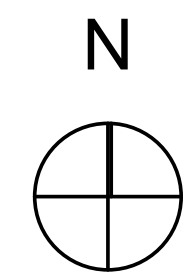
