SECTION A: DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS/WORK STATEMENT

The Department of General Services (“Department” or “DGS”) is seeking one or more Contractor(s) to provide Snow and Ice Removal Services for the District of Columbia’s Public Schools, Parks, and Recreational Facilities. This solicitation is set aside for Certified Business Enterprises certified by the District’s Department of Small, Local Business Development.

The Snow and Ice Removal Services provided by the Contractor(s) shall be in accordance with the Statement of Work below.

SECTION A: STATEMENT OF WORK

1. The Contractor shall provide snow and ice removal and chemical surface treatment at various schools, parks, and recreational facilities listed in Attachment A-Site Listing and at other locations as directed by the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative (COTR). Services shall be provided in accordance with the order of priority listed on Attachment A, with one (1) being the highest priority and five (5) being the lowest priority.
2. The Contractor shall furnish all the necessary tools, equipment, and materials including heavy equipment, salt spreaders, spreader attachments, snow shovels, snow blowers, but not limited to sand/salt mixtures, sand, ice melt, and other items that may be required for snow and ice removal. The Contractor shall have adequate resources to simultaneously meet the level of priority for each location within each group.
3. Time of performance is of the essence. DGS shall have first priority for any and all snow and ice removal services. The Contractor will receive an advance verbal notice two (2) hours prior to commencing performance. The minimum labor hours DGS shall be obligated to pay the Contractor once mobilization has commenced, will be two (2) hours at the standby rate as provided in Attachment B-Bid Form.
4. The Contractor shall ensure that all sites are free of snow and ice accumulation, and shall remain reasonably free of snow and ice throughout the snow event. Snow shall NOT be piled on or near trees, shrubbery, ground cover, grass, or flowerbed areas.
5. All parking areas and driveways shall be clear of snow and ice no later than (1) hour prior to the beginning of business hours, and as needed throughout the duration of the storm.
6. The Contractor shall not injure, damage, or destroy government property. The Contractor shall be held responsible for all damage to property, grounds and landscaping caused by equipment or the application of chemicals for ice and snow removal. All chemicals used shall be in accordance with Federal specifications and local codes. The Contractor shall use Magnesium Chloride ice-melt products (on concrete only) and sand (on asphalt only).

The Contractor shall provide to the COTR before their use, the brand name and literature on all chemicals, including environmentally friendly pretreatment materials, to be used in the performance of this contract.

7. Contractor shall furnish the COTR with a list of telephone numbers where either it or its authorized representative may be contacted seven (7) days per week at any hour of the day or night to provide the required services.

SECTION B: TERM OF CONTRACT

B.1 The term of this contract shall be for one year from date of award.

B.2 Option To Extend The Term Of The Contract

B.2.1 The District may extend the term of the Contract for a period of four (4) one (1) year Option Periods by providing a written notice thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the Contract; provided that the District shall give the Contractor preliminary written notice of its intent to exercise the option to extend the term of the Contract. The preliminary notice does not commit the District to an extension. Contractor may waive the thirty (30) day notice requirement by providing a written waiver to the Contracting Officer prior to the expiration of the Contract.

B.2.2 The price for the Option Period shall be specified in the Contract. The exercise of the option to extend the Contract is subject to the availability of funds at the time of the exercise of the option.

B.2.3 The option to extend the term of the contract, as described in B.2.1, shall be included in each option contract.

B.2.4 The total duration of the contract, including the exercise of any options under Section B.2 shall not exceed five (5) years.

SECTION C: CONTRACTOR FEES

The contract awarded pursuant to this IFB will be a Time and Materials type contract. Bidders are required to bid Time and Materials unit prices on the Bid Form (Attachment B). These unit prices will be the Bidder's sole compensation for work performed. Services shall be performed on an hourly basis. The Contractor shall not be paid overtime rates.

SECTION D: DELIVERABLES

The Contractor shall submit the chemical surface treatment Materials Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) and any other information required by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to the COTR prior to its application.

SECTION E: COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

E.1 Licensing, Accreditation and Registration

The Contractor and all of its subcontractors (regardless of tier) shall comply with all applicable District of Columbia, state, and federal licensing, accreditation, and registration requirements and standards necessary for the performance of the contract.

E.2 Service Contract Act

The selected Contractor shall agree that the work performed under this Contract shall be subject to Service Contract Wage Rates. The Contractor is bound by Wage Determination No. 2005-2103, Revision No. 12 dated June 13, 2012 issued by the U.S. Department of Labor in accordance with the Service Contract Act of 1965, as amended (41 U.S.C. 351). The Contractor shall be bound by the wage rates included as Attachment C for the term of the contract.

E.3 SLDBE Participation

A bidder responding to this solicitation must submit with its bid, a notarized statement detailing any subcontracting plan required by law. Bids responding to this IFB shall be deemed nonresponsive and shall be rejected if the Offeror fails to submit a subcontracting plan that is required by the law. For contracts in excess of \$250,000, at least 35% of the dollar volume of the contract shall be subcontracted.

E.4 Preference for Small, Local, and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

Under the provisions of the Small, Local, and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Development and Assistance Act of 2005, D.C. Law 16-33 (codified at D.C. Code § 2-218.01 et seq.), preferences shall be given to Bidders that are certified by the Department of Small and Local Business Development as being a small business enterprise, having resident business ownership, having a longtime resident business, being a local business enterprise, being a disadvantaged business enterprise, or being a local business enterprise with its principal Department located in an enterprise zone. (A copy of the certification acknowledgment letter must be submitted with the Bidder's Proposal.)

In accordance with D.C. Code § 2-218.01 et seq., the following preferences shall be awarded in evaluating a Bidder's submission:

- a. Three percent for a small business enterprise;
- b. Five percent for a resident-owned business;
- c. Ten percent for a longtime resident business;

- d. Two percent for a local business enterprise;
- e. Two percent for a local business enterprise with its principal office located in an enterprise zone; and
- f. Two percent for a disadvantaged business enterprise.

Bidders may qualify for more than one of these categories, so that the maximum number of points available under this section is 12 percent

E. 5 Residency Hiring Requirements for Contractors and Subcontractors

At least fifty-one percent (51%) of the Contractor's Team and every subcontractor's employees hired after the Contractor enters into a contract with the Department, or after such subcontractor enters into a contract with the Contractor, to work on this project, shall be residents of the District of Columbia.

Upon execution of the contract, the Contractor and all of its member firms, if any, and each of its subcontractors and subconsultants shall submit to the Department a list of current employees that will be assigned to the project, the date that they were hired and whether or not they live in the District of Columbia.

The Contractor shall comply with subchapter III of Chapter II of Title 1, and subchapter II of Chapter II of Title 1 of the D.C. Code, as amended and all successor acts thereto and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. The Contractor and all member firms, subcontractors, tier subcontractors, subconsultants, and suppliers with contracts in the amount of \$300,000 or more shall be required to comply with the following: (i) enter into a First Source Employment Agreement with the D.C. Department of Employment Services ("DOES") upon execution of the contract(Attachment F); (ii) submit an executed First Source Agreement to DOES prior to beginning work on the project (Attachment F); (iii) make best efforts to hire at least 51% District residents for all new jobs created by the project; (iv) list all employment vacancies with DOES; and (v) submit monthly compliance reports to DOES by the 10th of each month, or as required by the D.C. Code.

E. 6 District Resident Hours

The Department wishes to maximize the number of District residents working on this Contract. To that end, the Department will require that at least 51% of the hours worked on this Contract must be worked by District residents. Contractor should review the Form of Contract for further information.

E.7 Way to Work

The selected Contractor shall agree that the work performed under this Contract shall be subject to the District's Living Wage Act (Attachment G).

SECTION F: INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

F.1 Required Insurance

The Contractor will be required to maintain the following types of insurance throughout the life of the contract:

Commercial General Public Liability Insurance (“Liability Insurance”) against liability for bodily injury and death and property damage, such Liability Insurance to be in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for liability for bodily injury, death and property damage arising from any one occurrence and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the aggregate of all occurrences within each policy year. The policy should include completed operations coverage.

Workers’ Compensation and Employers Liability coverage providing statutory benefits for all persons employed by the Contractor, or its Contractors and subcontractors at or in connection with the Work.

Automobile Liability, including Hired and Non-Owned Auto Liability in the amount of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for each occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

F.2 Additional Insured

Each insurance policy shall be issued in the name of the Contractor and shall name as additional insured parties the Department and the District of Columbia, and shall not be cancelable or reduced without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Department.

F.3 Waiver of Subrogation

All such insurance shall contain a waiver of subrogation against the Department and the District of Columbia, and their respective agents.

F.4 Strength of Insurer

All insurance shall be placed with insurers that are reasonably acceptable to the Department and with an A.M. Best's rating of not less than A- (Excellent) and a surplus size of not less than XV. All such insurers shall be licensed/approved to do business in the District of Columbia.

SECTION G: EVALUATION AND AWARD CRITERIA

G.1 Method of Award

The Department reserves the right to accept/reject any/all bids resulting from this solicitation. The Contracting Officer may reject all bids or waive any minor informality or irregularity in bids received whenever it is determined that such action is in the best interest of the District.

The DGS intends to award one or more contracts resulting from this solicitation to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) as determined by the total sum of the fixed unit prices as provided in the Bid Form (Attachment B).

G.2 Preparation and Submission of Bids

Bidders shall submit one (1) signed original bid and three (3) copies to include Attachment B-Offer Letter and Bid Form, Attachment D-Disclosure Statement, Attachment E-Tax Affidavit, and Attachment F-First Source Agreement. The District will not accept a facsimile copy of a bid as an original bid. Each bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope conspicuously marked: "Snow and Ice Removal Services".

The original bid shall govern if there is a variance between the original bid and the copy submitted by the bidder.

Bidders shall make no changes to the requirements set forth in the solicitation.

SECTION H: PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

H.2 Date and Time for Receiving Submissions

Submissions shall be received no later than 2:00 p.m. on October 31, 2012. The Bidder assumes the sole responsibility for timely delivery of its submission, regardless of the method of delivery.

H.3 Bid Form

Each Bidder shall submit a bid form substantially in the form of the Offer Letter and Bid Form (Attachment B). Material deviations, in the opinion of the Department, from the bid form shall be sufficient to render the bid non-responsive.

H.4 Tax Affidavit

Each Bidder must submit a tax affidavit substantially in the form of Attachment E. In order to be eligible for this procurement, Bidders must be in full compliance with their tax obligations to the District of Columbia government.

H.5 Disclosure Statement

Each Bidder shall submit a Disclosure Statement (Attachment D)

H.6 Attachments

In addition to the Offer Letter and Bid Form (Attachment B), Disclosure Statement (Attachment D), Tax Affidavit (Attachment E), the Bidders shall also complete and submit the First Source Agreement (Attachment F).

Written questions, requests for interpretation or correction should be directed to Danyel Riley, Contract Specialist, at Danyel.Riley@dc.gov no later than 2:00 p.m. on October 29, 2012. The person making the request shall be responsible for prompt delivery.

I.2 Explanations to Prospective Bidders

Each Bidder should carefully examine this Invitation For Bids and any and all amendments, addenda or other revisions, and thoroughly familiarize itself with all requirements prior to proffering a submission. Should an Bidder find discrepancies or ambiguities in, or omissions from, the IFB and amendments, addenda or revisions, or otherwise desire an explanation or interpretation of the IFB, any amendments, addenda, or revisions, it must submit questions, requests for interpretation or correction in writing. Any information given to an Bidder concerning the solicitation shall be furnished promptly to all other Bidders as an amendment or addendum to this IFB if in the sole discretion of the Department that information is necessary in proffering submissions or if the lack of it would be prejudicial to any other prospective Bidders. Oral explanations or instructions given before the award of the contract shall not be binding.

I.3 Protests

Protests shall be governed by Section 4734 of the Department's Procurement Regulations (27 DCMR § 4734). Protests alleging defects in this solicitation must be filed prior to the time set for receipt of submissions. If an alleged defect does not exist in this initial IFB, but was incorporated into the IFB by an amendment or addendum, a protest based on that defect must be filed before the next closing time established for proffering submissions. In all other cases, a protester shall file the protest within ten (10) days after the protester knows or should have known whichever is earlier, of the facts and circumstances upon which the protest is based. All protests must be made in writing to the Department's Chief Contracting Officer ("CCO") and must be filed in duplicate. Protests shall be served on the Department by obtaining written and dated acknowledgment of receipt from the Department's CCO. Protests received by the Department after the indicated period shall not be considered. To expedite handling of protests, the envelope shall be labeled "Protest."

This section is intended to summarize the bid protest procedures and is for the convenience of the Bidders only. To the extent any provision of this section is inconsistent with the Procurement Regulations; the more stringent provisions shall prevail.

I.4 Contract Award

This procurement is being conducted in accordance Section 4720 of the Department's Procurement Regulations (27 DCMR § 4720).

I.5 Retention of Submissions

All submissions shall be retained by the Department and therefore shall not be returned to the Bidders. With the exception of proprietary financial information, the submissions shall become the property of the Department and the Department shall have the right to distribute or use such information as it determines.

I.6 Examination of Submissions

Bidders are expected to examine the requirements of all instructions (including all amendments, addenda, attachments and exhibits) in this IFB. Failure to do so shall be at the sole risk of the Bidder and may result in disqualification.

I.7 Late Submissions: Modifications

- A. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this IFB to the contrary, a late modification of an otherwise successful submission which makes its terms more favorable to the Department may be considered at any time it is received and may be accepted.
- B. Submissions shall be irrevocable and remain in full force and effect for a period not less than 120 days after receipt of submissions.

I.8 No Compensation for Preparation of Submissions

The Department shall not bear or assume any financial obligations or liabilities regarding the preparation of any submissions submitted in response to this IFB, or prepared in connection therewith, including, but without limitation, any submissions, statements, reports, data, information, materials or other documents or items.

I.9 Rejection of Submissions

The Department reserves the right, in its sole discretion:

- A. To cancel this solicitation or reject all submissions.
- B. To reject submissions that fail to prove the Bidder's responsibility.
- C. To reject submissions that contain conditions and/or contingencies that in the Department's sole judgment, make the submission indefinite, incomplete, otherwise non-responsive, or otherwise unacceptable for award.
- D. To waive minor irregularities in any submission provided such waiver does not result in an unfair advantage to any Bidder.

- E. To take any other action within the applicable Procurement Regulations or law.
- F. To reject the submission of any Bidder that has submitted a false or misleading statement, affidavit or certification in connection with such submission or this Request for Proposals.

I.10 Limitation of Authority

Only a person with prior written authority from the CCO shall have the express, implied, or apparent authority to alter, amend, modify, or waive any clauses or conditions of the contract. Furthermore, any alteration, amendment, modification, or waiver of any clause or condition of this IFB is not effective or binding unless made in writing and signed by the CCO or its authorized representative.
